**EB-2025-0093 – Hydro One Networks Inc. s.99 St. Clair Transmission Line Expropriation Application
– Voluntary Settlement Reached and Land Rights Registered on Title**

In accordance with the Ontario Energy Board's ("OEB") Decision and Order in this proceeding, dated September 4, 2025 (the "Decision and Order"), Hydro One Networks Inc. ("Hydro One") is providing the OEB the following notification consistent with Condition #1 of the Conditions of Approval¹.

Hydro One has reached voluntary land rights agreements with the landowners of three of the five parcels of land over which expropriation relief was granted by the OEB, specifically referenced as CK48, CK49, and CK53 in the proceeding. The sought land rights have now been registered on title for two of these three properties, CK48 and CK49. For property CK53, registration of the land rights is still pending. Hydro One will provide further notification to the OEB once registration on this property is complete.

Hydro One is confirming that it no longer requires expropriation relief for properties CK48 and CK49 as land rights have now been registered on title. Hydro One consents to the OEB varying the Decision and Order in this proceeding, accordingly. Hydro One also consents to the OEB disposing of this matter without a hearing, in accordance with section 21(4)(b) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.
