Issues:

Pollution Probe represents a consumer and policy interest related to Elexicon's 2027-2031 Custom Rate Application. The application includes approximately \$1.2 billion in proposed investments to meet Elexicon's energy consumers' needs in a cost-effective manner, while ensuring its plan and utility execution over the term aligns with energy transition and related policy demands. The application and underlying Business Plan and Distribution System Plan (DSP) term aligns with a critical period for system planning at a time when municipalities in its service territory are expanding and undertaking significant energy and emissions plan activity requiring increased electrification and distributed energy resources. Elexicon has been identified as a required enabler for energy transition plan coordination and delivery over this period.
