OVERVIEW

Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. (Milton Hydro) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, seeking approval to establish a variance account to record the revenue requirement impacts resulting from changes in shared services and corporate cost allocation.

The OEB granted Consumers Council of Canada (CCC), School Energy Coalition (SEC), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

On December 9, 2025, the OEB issued its Decision and Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received cost claims from CCC, SEC, and VECC. No objections to the cost claims were received from Milton Hydro.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that they are compliant with its [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Milton Hydro.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Milton Hydro shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
