DECISION AND ORDER

Saint-Gobain Canada Inc. (Saint-Gobain) filed an application on January 7, 2026, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence EW-2020-0274, which is set to expire on February 24, 2026.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity wholesaler licence to Saint-Gobain. The OEB notes that the initial application was filed by the applicant 48 days prior to the expiration of the existing licence. Applicants are reminded of the importance to apply for renewal of any licence sufficiently prior to the expiry date to allow for processing of the application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
