Issues:

Members and supporters of Energy Probe are residential customers of the Applicant. The rates they pay will be impacted by the outcome of this proceeding. Energy Probe was an intervenor in the EB-2024-0198 proceeding and opposed the roll-over of certain DSM programs because the costs of these programs exceeded benefits. Energy Probe is concerned that the costs of some of the programs proposed in this proceeding may also exceed benefits. However, Energy Probe supports the efforts by Enbridge Gas to reduce rate impacts on residential customers.

Policy Interests:

Energy Probe represents ratepayers who believe in policies that follow the principles of user pay and costs follow benefits. This outcome of this proceeding may result in increased cross-subsidies between customers who pay for DSM programs and who those who benefit from them.

Hearings:

Energy Probe does not believe that there is a good reason for having a specific form of hearing.

Evidence:

Energy Probe does not intend to file evidence in the proceeding.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

Energy Probe intends to coordinate its efforts with intervenors with similar interests by sharing plans for interrogatories, technical conference, and the hearing to avoid duplication.

Cost Awards:

Energy Probe applies for recovery of its reasonably incurred costs during its intervention in this proceeding. Energy Probe is a non-profit organization which relies on individual donations to help protect the public interest. Without the prospect of an award of costs, Energy Probe's ability to participate in OEB proceedings would be limited. Energy Probe's members and supporters are customers of the Applicant and are eligible for an award of costs according to Practice Directions. Energy Probe has participated in many past natural gas and electricity proceedings in Ontario, including consultations, rate cases, and other processes and hearings, and has been found eligible to be paid its reasonably incurred costs.

Language Preference:

Energy Probe intends to participate using the English language.
