Re: EB-2025-0252: Alectra Utilities Inc. (“Alectra Utilities”) 2027 Rebasing Application (the “Application”)– Request for Confidential Treatment of Information in Interrogatory Responses

Alectra Utilities filed interrogatory responses (“IRRs”) on February 20, 2026. Pursuant to the OEB’s *Practice Direction on Confidential Filings* (the “**Practice Direction**”), Alectra Utilities hereby requests OEB approval (i) for confidential treatment under Parts 5 and 6 of the Practice Direction, and/or (ii) to permanently redact from the public record, information that is (a) not relevant pursuant to Part 11 of the Practice Direction, and (b) personal information pursuant to Part 10 of the Practice Direction, for certain information contained in the IRRs.

The proposed redactions are further detailed in Schedule A of this letter, which is a table prepared in accordance with Section 5.1.4(b) of the Practice Direction, which includes:

Alectra Utilities does not seek confidential treatment of that publicly available information. However, the report discusses aspects of individuals' compensation information that are private. Alectra Utilities has redacted information that pertains to those nonpublic aspects of individuals' compensation.
