Re: EB-2025-0312 Elexicon Energy Inc. 2027-2031 Custom Rate Application – Request for Evidence Presentation

Elexicon Energy (“Elexicon”) writes to the Ontario Energy Board (the “OEB”) with respect to the above-noted proceeding to request an opportunity to present an overview of its application (an “Evidence Presentation”) at the start of the Technical Conference, or at another time that would be convenient for the Panel in advance of the Settlement Conference.

The Evidence Presentation would provide the Panel and the parties with a comprehensive summary of the utility’s operating context, Investment Plan, rate framework, bill impacts, and other key elements of the application. Since this is Elexicon’s first rebasing application as a consolidated utility, and its legacy rates have not undergone a cost-of-service review in more than twelve years, the utility believes that this presentation will be helpful to the Panel and interested parties in better understanding the application and the approvals being requested.

Elexicon proposes that the Evidence Presentation be transcribed and form part of the record of the proceeding. For regulatory efficiency, Elexicon also proposes that questions during the Evidence Presentation are limited to the OEB Panel, as OEB Staff and intervenors will have the opportunity to ask questions throughout the Technical Conference and/or Settlement Conference process.

In making this request, Elexicon notes that Evidence Presentations have been granted by the OEB in a number of major rate proceedings, including most recently in Toronto Hydro’s 2025-2029 Custom Rate Application (EB-2023-0195).
