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# DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS

**EB-2025-0027**

**INNPOWER CORPORATION**

**Application for rates and other charges effective January 1, 2026**

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## OVERVIEW

InnPower Corporation (InnPower) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 14, 2025, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates to be effective January 1, 2026. InnPower requested approval to establish four new deferral accounts under Account 1508 to track net incremental revenues, costs, and carrying charges related to small cell wireless pole attachments which were not included in its approved 2024 revenue requirement. InnPower also applied to recover operating and capital costs related to restoration work from a Z-Factor event, related to an ice storm, through two rate riders, effective January 1, 2026.

On September 24, 2025, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 granting status and cost eligibility to the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC).

On December 19, 2025, the OEB issued its Decision and Rate Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received a cost claim from VECC. No objection to the cost claim was received from InnPower.

## Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claim filed to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claim is reasonable and shall be reimbursed by InnPower Corporation.

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, InnPower Corporation shall promptly pay \$2,425.43 to VECC.
