**Re: InnPower Corporation (InnPower)  
2027 Electricity Distribution Rates (EB-2026-0052)**

The OEB is in receipt of InnPower's letter dated January 27, 2026 (Letter). In the Letter, InnPower notifies the OEB of its intention to file an application in the second quarter of 2026 to rebase its rates effective January 1, 2027, which would be prior to the end of Innpower's standard five-year rebasing period in 2029.

As indicated in the [OEB's December 17, 2025 letter](#), a distributor seeking to have its rates rebased earlier than scheduled must clearly demonstrate, in its application, why early rebasing is required. Specifically, the distributor must clearly demonstrate why and how it cannot adequately manage its resources and financial needs during the remainder of its IRM period. The OEB expects InnPower to include this information in its 2027 rate application evidence.

As it has done so in other cases, the OEB will make a pre-application meeting available to InnPower should it wish to receive early feedback on its rebasing application, including the rationale for early rebasing, prior to finalizing it. As indicated in the [OEB's cover letter](#) for the 2022 filing requirements update, the OEB will extend an invitation to stakeholders that intervened in the most recent cost of service proceedings for InnPower's predecessor distributors, unless InnPower prefers to seek feedback only from OEB staff.

The purpose of a pre-application meeting is not to settle any issues. The panel of the OEB hearing the application will determine the matters outlined in your letter once the application is filed.
