Re: Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. Correction of Residential MIST Meter Rate Rider (EB-2025-0021)

Dear Mr. Murray,

When reviewing Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. (NT Power's) tariff for the Newmarket-Tay Rate Zone (NTRZ) during its January billings process, NT Power noted that the MIST meter rate rider for residential customers effective January 1, 2026 was incorrect. NT Power proposes to correct the rate rider effective January 1, 2026, and is providing an amended set of tariffs in Appendix A.

NT Power erroneously calculated the residential rate rider to recover amounts relating to MIST meters for NTRZ. In the calculation of the monthly fixed rate rider, NT Power omitted dividing the annual amount by 12. NT Power has currently completed billings for January 2026, and will begin billing for February 2026 shortly. NT Power apologizes for the oversight and is proposing the following remedy:

- Correct the MIST rate rider on the tariff, effective January 1, 2026
- Apply a billing correction to the impacted customers' bills to refund the over-collected amount, as soon as practicable
- Apply the corrected rate rider of \$0.10/customer going forward, as soon as practicable

NT Power proposes to do a billing correction and correct the rate rider going forward instead of ceasing the current rate rider effective February 1, 2026 to ensure that the appropriate customers are billed.

NT Power proposes to apply the corrected rate rider in its next billing cycle. NT Power would appreciate a decision on this matter by March 11, 2026, or earlier, to allow for implementation of the corrected rate rider in the next billing cycle.
