**LETTER OF DIRECTION**

Dear Evan Tomek:

**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas)  
2026 Storage Enhancement Project  
Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2026-0082**

On February 20, 2026, Enbridge Gas applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 38(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for an order to vary the operating pressure in its Dawn 156, Bentpath and Rosedale natural gas storage pools above the pressure previously set by the OEB. Enbridge Gas also applied for approval to the Minister of Natural Resources (Minister) for a well drilling licence for a new natural gas storage well in the Rosedale storage pool. The Minister has referred the application to the OEB and the OEB is required to report back to the Minister.

The OEB has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas's 2026 storage enhancement Project application (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 to 3 below prior to **March 26, 2026**. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at [registrar@oeb.ca](mailto:registrar@oeb.ca).

You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed project.
2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas' website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service and receipt of the

enclosed Notice, in the exact form accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:

- a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
- b. the clerks of the Township of Dawn-Euphemia, the Township of Enniskillen and the County of Lambton
- c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed project
- d. the Métis Nations of Ontario - Lands Resources and Consultations Suite 1100 – 66 Slater Street, Ottawa ON K1P 5H1
- e. all affected utilities and railway companies
- f. St. Clair Region Conservation Authority
- g. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- h. The Ministry of Natural Resources – Petroleum Operations Section, London Ontario

(Note: It is acceptable to serve the evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

3. To post the enclosed Notice(s), the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, on Enbridge Gas's website.
4. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.
5. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
