OVERVIEW

Elexicon Energy Inc. (Elexicon Energy) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on July 15, 2025, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates for the Veridian Rate Zone and the Whitby Rate Zone effective January 1, 2026. The application also requested incremental capital funding to rebuild the Sandy Beach Substation and for the installation of a new Dual Element Spot Network.

The OEB granted the Coalition of Concerned Manufacturers and Businesses of Canada (CCMBC), Consumers Council of Canada (CCC), Quinte Manufacturers Association (QMA), School Energy Coalition (SEC), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) intervenor status and cost award eligibility.

On February 5, 2026, the OEB issued its Final Rate Order in which it set out the process for cost claims.

The OEB received cost claims from CCMBC, CCC, QMA, SEC and VECC. No objections were raised by Elexicon Energy.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims to ensure that they are compliant with the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Elexicon Energy Inc.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Elexicon Energy Inc. shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
 - Coalition of Concerned Manufacturers and Businesses of Canada \$5,476.55
 - Consumers Council of Canada \$13,273.56
 - Quinte Manufacturers Association \$4,308.14
 - School Energy Coalition \$12,411.57
 - Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition \$7,089.75
