# **MILTON HYDRO DISTRIBUTION INC.**

**Application for a Service Area Amendment**

## DECISION AND ORDER

Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. (Milton Hydro) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on January 7, 2026, under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an amendment to Milton Hydro's service area as described in Schedule 1 of its electricity distribution licence ED-2003-0014. Schedule 1 of the licence sets out the service area within which Milton Hydro is authorized to provide electricity distribution services.

The application has been considered by the Delegated Authority without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Milton Hydro requested the amendment to include the property described as 111 Fellows Rd., Eramosa (Milton), northwest of Highway 7, at the intersection of Fellows Rd and Highway 7, with the legal description Eramosa CON 6 PT LOT 1 RP (Subject Property) to its service area. The Subject Property is currently part of Hydro One's service area as described in Schedule 1 of its electricity distribution licence ED-2003-0043. Milton Hydro's application included a letter from Hydro One stating that Hydro One supports Milton Hydro's application.

The proposed service area amendment is necessary in order that Milton Hydro may provide electricity distribution services to 1000001947 Ontario Inc., a commercial customer who has requested service from Milton Hydro at the Subject Property. The Subject Property is currently vacant and is being prepared as a parking lot for trailers.

The evidence filed with the application states that Milton Hydro has distribution facilities in place adjacent to the Subject Property, whereas Hydro one does not, and that Milton Hydro has sufficient capacity on its existing distribution facilities to supply the customer's load. The evidence also states that no assets will be stranded because of the proposed amendment. Further, the evidence states that the rates of both distributors will be unaffected and there will be no effect on safety, reliability or service quality.

Based on the evidence, the OEB finds it to be in the public interest to approve the service area amendment to include the Subject Property in Schedule 1 of Milton Hydro's electricity distribution licence. Hydro One's distribution licence ED-2003-0043 does not need to be amended given the manner in which Schedule 1 of Hydro One's licence is presented.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Milton Hydro Inc.'s electricity distribution licence ED-2003-0014, is amended to include the following in Schedule 1:

111 Fellows Rd., Eramosa (Milton), northwest of Highway 7, at the intersection of Fellows Rd and Highway 7. Eramosa CON 6 PT LOT 1 RP.

The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
