### 3 INTRODUCTION

Entegrus Powerlines Inc. (“Entegrus”) is making this uncontested Service Area Amendment application (the “Application”) to the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) pursuant to Section 74(1) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 for the purpose of amending the licensed service area of Entegrus to include 9783 Wellington Road in St. Thomas, Ontario, (the “Subject Area”), owned by Land Rise Development Inc. (the “Developer”). The Subject Area is located in the northwest section of the City of St. Thomas, Ontario, within the municipal boundary and immediately adjacent to Entegrus’ existing service area.

The Subject Area is shown in Exhibit 5.

The Subject Area is currently shown as an exclusion from the Entegrus Distribution License on page 10, under the heading “The St. Thomas Energy Inc. Rate Zone”, specifically under item 1 (xiii), and the exclusion is described as follows:

- 9783 Wellington Rd, St. Thomas, consisting of Gore Lot 44 Concession North of the Talbot Road, Geographic Township of Southwold in the city of St. Thomas, County of Elgin PIN 35169-0236

For the reasons set out herein, it is in the public interest to amend Schedule 1 of the Entegrus Distribution Licence to remove the exclusion from the Entegrus distribution licence such that Entegrus can serve the above Subject Area.

In considering this application, Entegrus understands that the Board will be guided by the principles articulated in the Board's Filing Requirements for Service Area Amendment Applications dated March 12, 2007, and included as Chapter 7 of the Filing Requirements for Transmission and Distribution Application, together with the Board's Decision with Reasons in the RP-2003-0044 combined service area amendments proceeding (the “Combined Proceeding”). This Application fits with the applicable principles and satisfies each of the filing requirements. The Developer has indicated that it prefers Entegrus as the distributor for the Subject Area. A copy of the letter of support has been included in Exhibit 6.

Hydro One does not oppose this Application and the required expansion of Entegrus’ service territory to service the Subject Area. A copy of the Hydro One letter of consent is included in Exhibit 7. Given the

manner in which Schedule 1 of Hydro One's licence is presented, it would not need to be amended if this SAA application is approved.

Entegrus requests that the Board dispose of this Application without a hearing pursuant to Section 21(4) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998. As described further below, no person will be affected in a material way by the outcome of this Application other than Entegrus, Hydro One (who does not oppose this Application) and the Developer (who prefers Entegrus).

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## **4.2 REASONS FOR AMENDMENT**

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The service area amendment proposed in this Application is in the public interest as defined in the Combined Proceeding, for the following reasons:

1. The proposed Service Area Amendment (“SAA”) is consistent with the objective of a rational and efficient service area alignment based on both economic (cost) efficiency and the efficient use of existing distribution resources.
2. Entegrus has infrastructure across the road to the Subject Area that can provide the required electrical service with minimal investment. In comparison, Hydro One’s closest similar supply point is approximately 500 metres further distant. The Applicant submits it is more efficient and rational to connect the customer to its existing distribution system. Hydro One does not oppose this SAA application (see Exhibit 7).
3. Entegrus can provide service to the Subject Area that is comparable to Hydro One in terms of system planning, safety and service reliability.
4. The proposed SAA will not result in stranded or duplicated assets.
5. The incorporation of the Subject Area into Entegrus’ Service Area will be seamless. The Subject Area is between Entegrus area to the east, west and south. Until 2017, the Subject Area was included in Entegrus’ service area.
6. The Developer's preference is that Entegrus service the Subject Area (see Exhibit 6).

## **4.3 DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED SERVICE AREA**

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The Subject Area is generally referred to as 9783 Wellington Rd, St. Thomas. The Developer’s initial and immediate plan is to construct a subdivision project (“Project”) at the Subject Area that will consist of 89 services (8 townhouse residential dwellings and 81 single detached residential dwellings).

The legal description of the Subject Area is described in Section 3 above.

Exhibit 4 shows the proposed and existing facilities surrounding the area.

Exhibit 5 shows the full extent of property owned by the Developer.

Collectively, these maps identify the Subject Area, the existing borders of Entegrus and Hydro One, the area around the Subject Area, and the existing and proposed infrastructure supplying the Subject Area. Some details (such as locations of lot lines) are subject to change as the development proceeds.

#### **4.5 DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED PHYSICAL CONNECTION**

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The Project consists of 89 services (townhouse and single detached residential dwellings). The Developer has requested connection immediately.

The Project will be supplied by a three-phase riser under Wellington Road from the existing Entegrus overhead system. The point of connection is adjacent to the intersection of Wellington Road and the proposed Sandymount Parkway and will run alongside Sandymount Parkway.

The existing and proposed infrastructures are shown in Exhibit 4.

#### **4.6 FUTURE EXPANSIONS IN ADJACENT LANDS**

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The Site Plan shown in Exhibit 3 and the Developer Owned Property Map in Exhibit 5 identify the property owned by the Developer. The Developer may construct additional residential dwellings in future phases of the Project.

## **5 EFFICIENT RATIONALIZATION OF THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM**

The proposed SAA will result in a rational and efficient service area and make efficient use of existing Entegrus distribution assets which are across the road to the point of connection.

### **5.1 LOCATION OF THE POINTS OF DELIVERY AND CONNECTION**

As noted above, the Subject Area is within Entegrus' historic service territory and across the road from existing Entegrus infrastructure. Entegrus submits that the proposed SAA promotes economic efficiency and efficient and rationale use of existing distribution assets.

Exhibit 1 shows the existing Entegrus infrastructure running along Wellington Road adjacent to the new development.

Entegrus understands that Hydro One would, comparatively, supply this development by extending its existing distribution system approximately 500 metres from the north on Wellington Road.

### **5.2 PROXIMITY TO DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM**

The Subject Area is within Entegrus' historic service territory but is currently excluded from Entegrus' licence due to a previous LTLT to serve facilities that no longer exist (EB-2017-0192). The proximity of Hydro One's territory is shown in Exhibit 2.

### **5.3 FULLY ALLOCATED CONNECTION COSTS**

Entegrus submits that it is more efficient and rational to connect the customer to its existing distribution system as it is physically closer and it avoids duplicate assets being built in the area.

Entegrus has infrastructure across the road (Wellington Road) from the Subject Area that can provide the required electrical service with minimal investment. In comparison, the incumbent distributor is approximately 500 metres further distant to the north. The Applicant submits it is more economically efficient to connect the customer to its existing distribution system. Hydro One does not oppose this SAA application (see Letter of Consent at Exhibit 7).

#### **5.4 CAPITAL CONTRIBUTION**

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Entegrus submits that it is more efficient and rational to connect the customer to its existing distribution system as it is physically closer and it avoids duplicate assets being built in the area.

#### **5.5 STRANDED EQUIPMENT COSTS**

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There will be no stranded equipment due to the proposed SAA. Consequently, the costs are nil.

#### **5.6 INFRASTRUCTURE RELIABILITY**

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The proposed SAA will not have any adverse effects on reliability in the Subject Area or adjacent areas. This will be an incremental expansion of Entegrus distribution system.

#### **5.7 COST-EFFECTIVENESS OF FUTURE EXPANSIONS**

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The infrastructure proposed by Entegrus will adequately supply the Project (89 services) as well as future expansions that may occur within the Subject Area.

#### **5.8 COST-EFFECTIVENESS OF IMPROVEMENTS AND UPGRADES**

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The infrastructure proposed by Entegrus will not adversely affect the cost-effectiveness of future improvements and upgrades in the area.

## **6 IMPACTS ARISING FROM THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT**

### **6.1 AFFECTED CUSTOMERS AND LAND OWNERS**

The Subject Area is vacant land owned by the Developer. The Developer supports the proposed SAA. There are no other customers affected.

### **6.2 CUSTOMER IMPACTS WITHIN SUBJECT AREA**

There are currently no customers in the Subject Area. The Developer (who represents the future customers) supports the SAA.

### **6.3 CUSTOMER IMPACTS OUTSIDE SUBJECT AREA**

Approval of this SAA will not result in any negative impacts on cost, rates, service quality, and reliability for Entegrus' existing customers. The additional customers will have a marginally favorable impact on Entegrus' future costs and rates due to the additional distribution revenue.

### **6.4 DISTRIBUTOR IMPACTS**

Approval of this SAA will not result in any negative impact on Entegrus' costs, service quality or reliability. Instead, Entegrus will have a favorable customer impact in terms of Entegrus' future costs and rates with additional customer growth and distribution revenue.

### **6.5 STRANDED AND REDUNDANT ASSETS**

No assets will be stranded or made redundant as a result of this SAA.

### **6.6 TRANSFERRED ASSETS**

No assets will be transferred as a result of this SAA.

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## **6.7 TRANSFERRED CUSTOMERS**

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No customers will be transferred as a result of this SAA.

## **6.8 ELIMINATED LOAD TRANSFERS OR RETAIL POINTS**

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This Application does not eliminate any LTLTs and no LTLT currently exists at the Subject Area.

## **6.9 NEW LOAD TRANSFERS OR RETAIL POINTS**

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No new load transfers or retail points of supply will be created by this SAA.

## **6.10 WRITTEN CONFIRMATION OF FULL DISCLOSURE**

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Entegrus confirms that all affected parties have been provided with specific and factual information about the proposed SAA.

## **6.11 CONSENT OF INCUMBENT DISTRIBUTOR**

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Hydro One has provided a Letter of Consent to this SAA, which is attached as Exhibit 7.

## **6.12 CONSENT OF DEVELOPER**

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The Developer has provided their consent via a letter of support attached as Exhibit 6.

## **6.13 MITIGATION EFFORTS RELATED TO CUSTOMER AND ASSET TRANSFER**

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No customers or assets will be transferred as a result of this SAA.

## 7 CUSTOMER PREFERENCE

The Developer has indicated their preference to have Entegrus supply this Development, as noted in their letter of support attached as Exhibit 6.

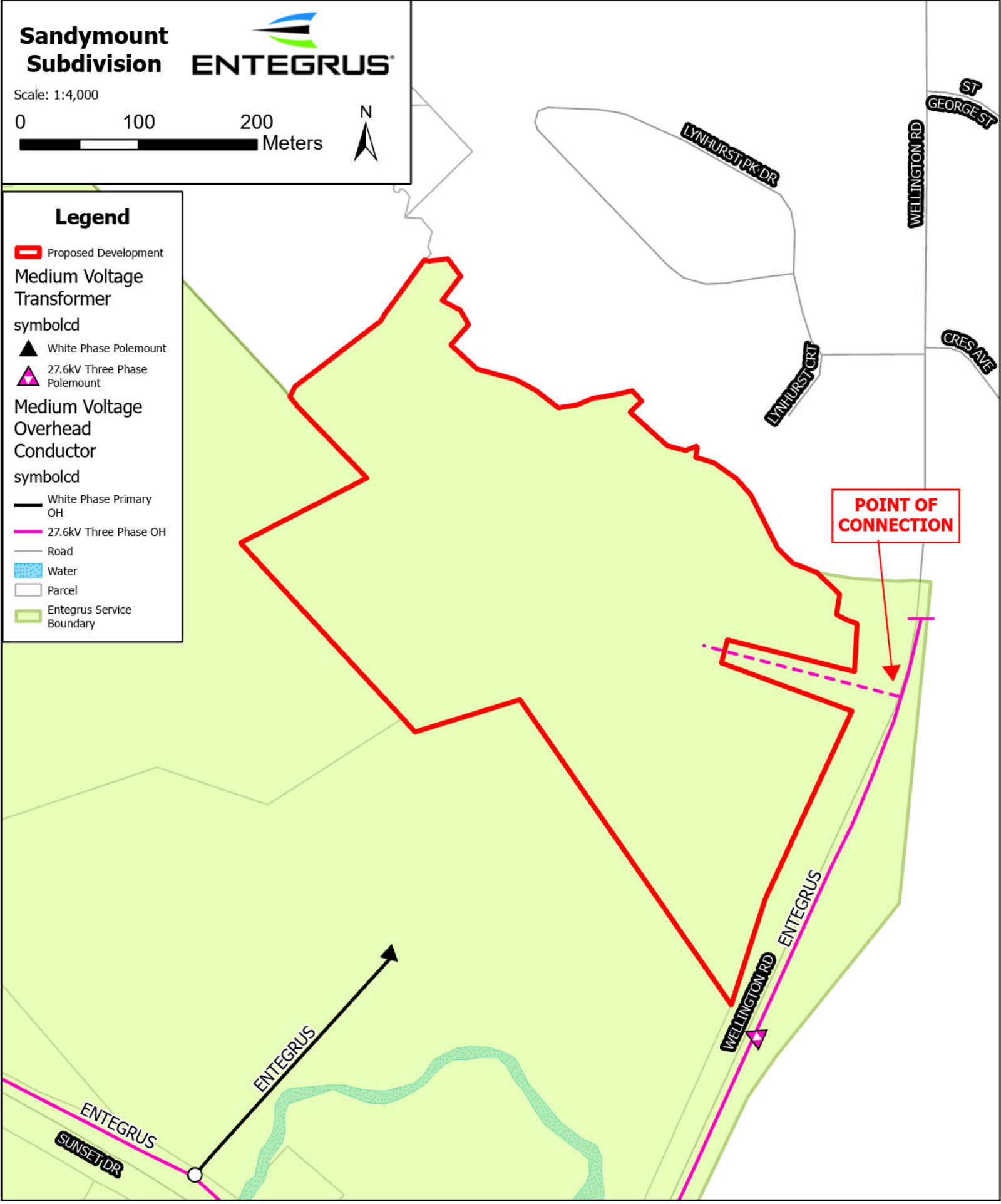

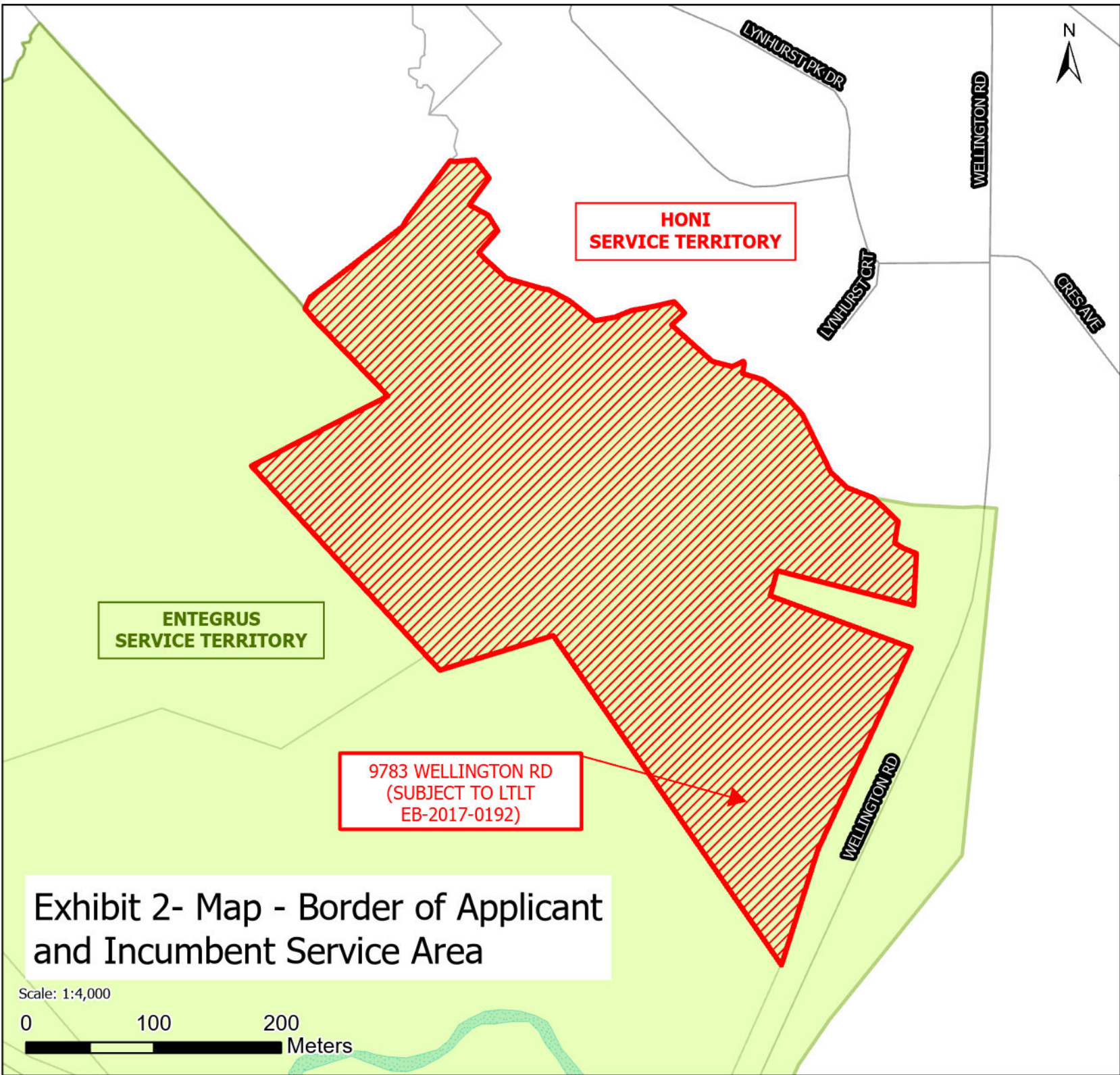

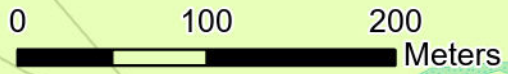

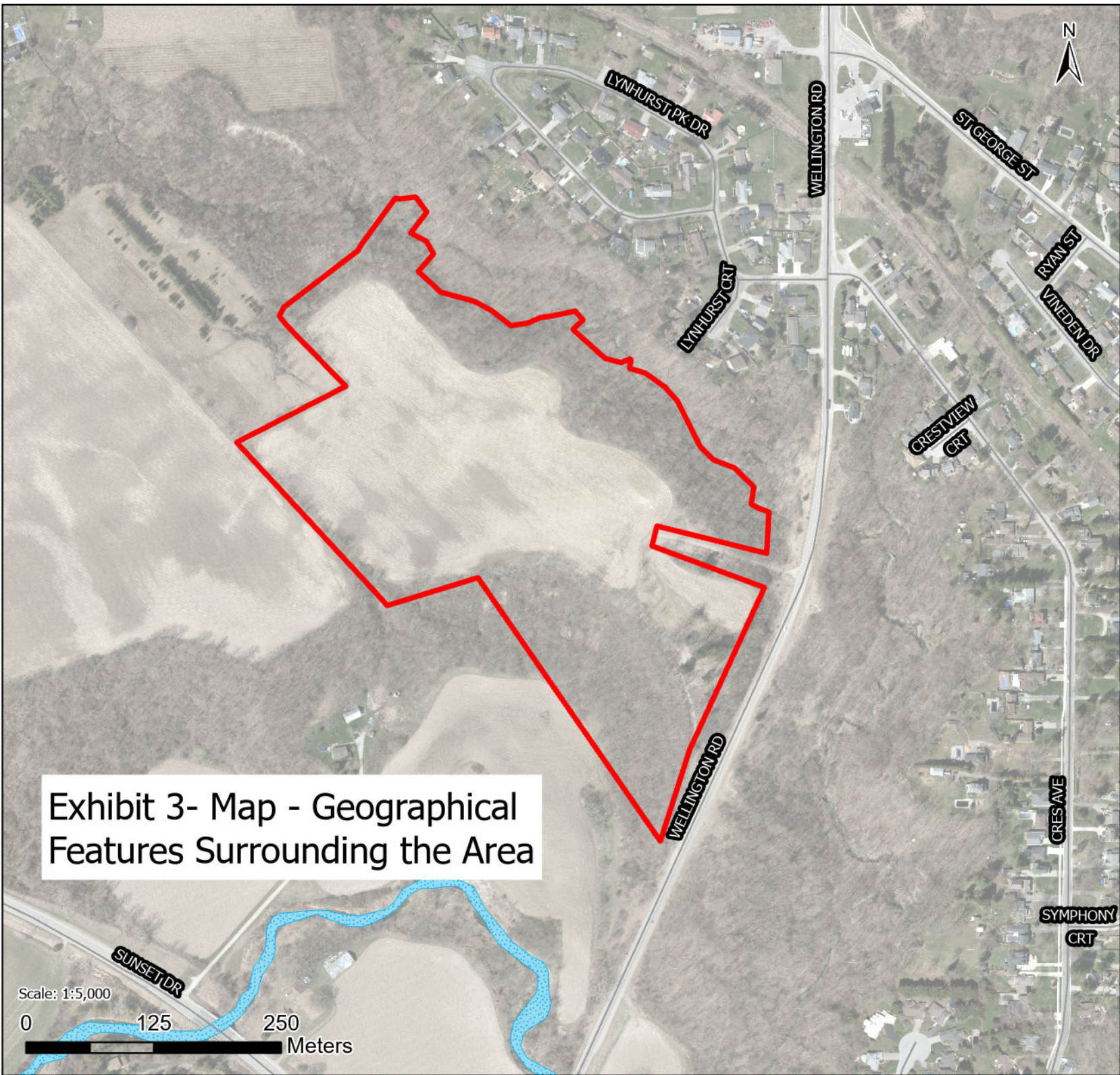


Exhibit 3- Map - Geographical Features Surrounding the Area

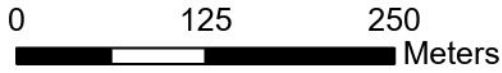

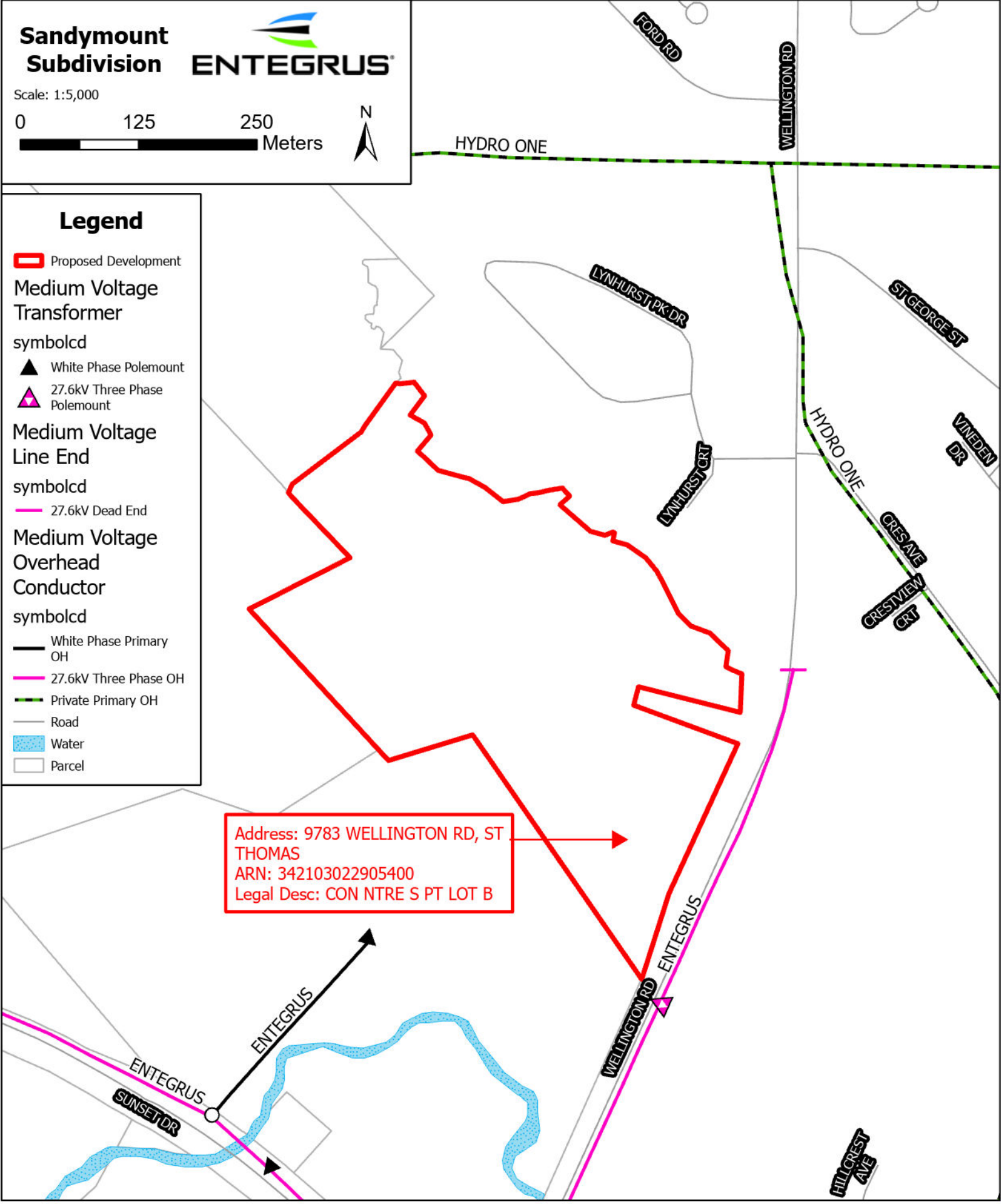


Exhibit 4 - Map - Proposed & Existing Facilities Supplying the Area

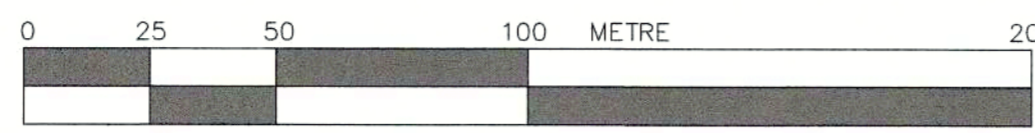

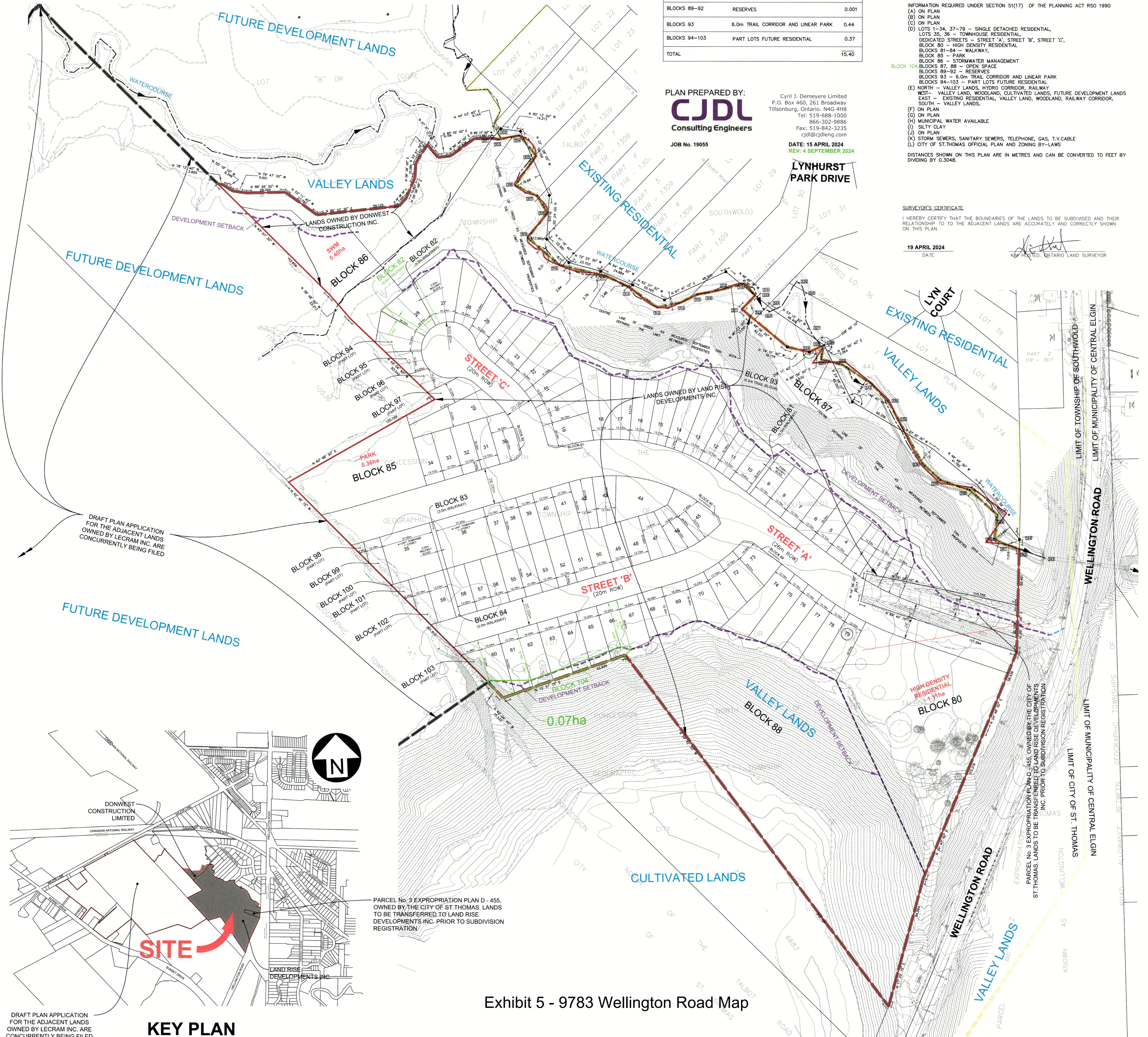

This letter is to confirm Hydro One Networks Inc.'s ("Hydro One") consents to Entegrus Powerlines Inc.'s ("Entegrus Powerlines") application to amend the existing Entegrus Powerlines Distribution Licence as proposed in the service area amendment application ("SAA Application") for 9783 Wellington Rd, in the city of St. Thomas (the "Subject Area").
