**Preamble:**

Six Nations stated that the affidavit provides important evidence regarding consultation meetings between Enbridge Gas and Six Nations.

The evidence of Six Nations outlines the consultation process related to the Port Colborne application starting with first notification by Enbridge Gas on April 22, 2025, and continuing until November 25, 2025.

The evidence describes the issues and concerns raised by Six Nations and Enbridge Gas' activities in response to Six Nations' concerns. The concerns of Six Nations include a lack of baseline data in Enbridge Gas' route selection methodology, cumulative impacts of the Port Colborne Project, and the adequacy of the Environmental Report. Six Nations expressed that Enbridge Gas "...failed to take seriously..."<sup>1</sup> their concerns. Six Nations submitted that Enbridge Gas filed the application with the OEB while the consultation was "...only just beginning..."<sup>2</sup> Six Nations' evidence included information on June 10, 2025, October 9, 2025, and November 25, 2025, consultation meetings.

Please describe the dates, format, scope and nature of consultation between Enbridge Gas and Six Nations following the meeting on November 25, 2025.

Please discuss if the issues and concerns raised by Six Nations were addressed or resolved in consultation with Enbridge Gas after November 25, 2025.
