OVERVIEW

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 14, 2025, under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* seeking approval to dispose of amounts recorded in certain 2023 deferral and variance accounts (DVAs), related to the delivery of natural gas conservation and energy efficiency programs.

On February 12, 2026, the OEB issued its Decision and Order in which it set out the dates and process for filing cost claims. Cost eligible intervenors were required to submit their cost claims by March 27, 2026.

The OEB received cost claims from Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME), Ontario Greenhouse Vegetable Growers (OGVG), and School Energy Coalition (SEC). No objections were raised by Enbridge Gas.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Enbridge Gas.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enbridge Gas Inc. shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:

• CME	\$2,286.51
• OGVG	\$1,500.98
• SEC	\$3,610.45
