Re: EB-2025-0252: Alectra Utilities Corporation (“Alectra Utilities”) 2027-2031 Custom Rate Application for Electricity Distribution Rates and Charges – Confidentiality Request Reply Submission for Undertaking Responses

On March 27, 2026, Alectra Utilities filed undertaking responses in respect of its custom rate application for electricity distribution rates and charges for the 2027-2031 period (the Application) with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB). The undertakings were filed in conjunction with a request by Alectra Utilities for confidential treatment for certain information under Parts 5 and 6 of the *Practice Direction on Confidential Filings* (the “Practice Direction”), and/or to permanently redact from the public record information that is not relevant or contains personal information under Parts 10 and 11 of the Practice Direction.

OEB Staff filed a submission regarding Alectra Utilities’ confidentiality request on April 6, 2026. In its submission, OEB Staff did not have any concerns with Alectra Utilities’ proposed redactions, except with respect to those contained in JT-1.17. OEB Staff also provided observations about some discrepancies and invited Alectra Utilities to clarify certain aspects of its confidentiality request. Alectra Utilities appreciates the opportunity to address OEB Staff’s observations in the sections that follow.

1. JT-1.17

OEB Staff disagreed with the following redactions in JT-1.17 and stated that the information appears to be based on an aggregate assumption of total connections and does not reveal specific customer load profile or energy usage:

- Page 4 – Table 3, Customer Connection/Load
- Page 5 – Table 4, Customer Connection/Load
- Page 6 – Table 5, Customer Connection/Load for residential customers and GS>50
- Page 7 – Table 6, Customer Connection/Load for residential customers and GS>50

Having reviewed OEB Staff's comments, Alectra Utilities agrees that the above listed redactions may be removed.

2. JT-3.8 and JT-3.24 Attachments

OEB Staff observed that the page numbers identified in Alectra Utilities' confidentiality letter differed from the page numbers in the respective attachments. Alectra Utilities clarifies that the confidentiality letter referenced the page numbers in the attachment (i.e., JT-3.8, Attachment 1, page 1) and not the page numbers for each individual document within that attachment or the PDF pages for the filing in which these attachments are included. Alectra Utilities appreciates OEB Staff's observations and will provide the page numbers for each individual document in future submissions. Alectra Utilities confirms that the page numbers identified by OEB Staff in Table 1 of its submission are correct.


Alectra Utilities also clarifies that there was no information redacted on page 12 of JT-3.24 and the reference to JT-3.24 and page 57 should have been removed from Schedule A.

3. JT-1.1.13, Attachment 1

Alectra Utilities confirms that pages 128-129 of JT-1.1.13, Attachment 1 were permanently redacted.
