Decision and Order

Hamilton Health Sciences Corporation (Hamilton Health Sciences) filed an application on March 17, 2026 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), to amend electricity generation licence EG-2021-0199.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Hamilton Health Sciences is seeking an amendment to update the nameplate capacity of the generation facilities listed in Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence. Schedule 1 identifies the generation facilities that a licensee is authorized to own and/or operate. Hamilton Health Sciences has explained that the generators for each facility were replaced with new generators in 2023, resulting in increased nameplate capacity for each generation facility. There are no other changes requested to the licence.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Hamilton Health Sciences Corporation's application to amend Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence EG-2021-0199 is granted. All other provisions of Licence EG-2021-0199 remain the same. The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
