OVERVIEW

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 9, 2025, under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, for an order granting leave to construct approximately 3.1 kilometres of natural gas pipelines and related assets to meet the requests of existing customers, Petro-Canada Lubricants Inc. (PCLI), CRH Canada Group Inc., and CertainTeed Canada Inc. for incremental natural gas service (Project). Enbridge Gas has also applied to the OEB for approval of the form of land-use agreements it offers to landowners for the routing and construction of the project.

On February 19, 2026, the OEB issued its Decision and Order in which it set out the dates and process for filing cost claims. Cost eligible intervenors were required to submit their cost claims by March 5, 2026.

The OEB received cost claims from Environmental Defence and, Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA). No objections were raised by Enbridge Gas.

Findings

The OEB has reviewed the claims filed to ensure that it is compliant with the OEB's [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Enbridge Gas.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enbridge Gas Inc. shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
