Re: EB-2008-0003 OEB Proposed Transmission System Code Amendments for Connecting Generation Facilities that Form Part of Renewable Resource Clusters

The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) generally supports the OEB proposed amendments to the Transmission System Code regarding cost responsibility associated with enabler facilities for renewable resources. The EDA notes that the proposed changes would address the coordination problems under the status quo by allowing transmitters to play a leading role in the design, development and construction of enabler facilities, while ensuring a level playing field between generators regarding connection costs. With respect to the next steps in approving enabler facilities and designating transmitters, the EDA hopes that the roles and responsibilities are clearly defined to avoid unnecessary confusion and delay.
