Issues:

Members and supporters of Energy Probe are natural gas ratepayers. The rates they pay will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Should the OEB approve Energy Probe's intervention in this proceeding, Energy Probe will be represented by its consultant, Tom Ladanyi. He participated in the RP-1999-0048, the last review of the Model Franchise Agreement 26 years ago as an employee of Enbridge Consumers Gas and has managed 16 franchise renewal applications. Energy Probe believes that his experience will be of assistance to the Commissioners and other parties in this proceeding.

Policy Interests:

Energy Probe believes in the user pay principle. Natural gas ratepayers should not be charged for the costs that should be paid by municipal taxpayers.

Hearings:

Energy Probe does not believe that there is a good reason for having a specific form of hearing.

Evidence:

Energy Probe does not intend to file evidence in the proceeding.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

Energy Probe intends to coordinate its efforts with intervenors with similar interests by sharing plans for interrogatories, technical conference, and the hearing to avoid duplication.

Cost Awards:

Energy Probe applies for recovery of its reasonably incurred costs during its intervention in this proceeding. Energy Probe is a non-profit organization which relies on individual donations to help protect the public interest. Without the prospect of an award of costs, Energy Probe's ability to participate in OEB proceedings would be limited. Energy Probe's members and supporters are natural gas consumers and are eligible for an award of costs according to section 3.03(a) of the Practice Directions. Energy Probe has participated in many past natural gas and electricity proceedings in Ontario, including consultations, rate cases, and other processes and hearings, and has been found eligible to be paid its reasonably incurred costs.

Language Preference:

Energy Probe does not intend to participate using the French language.
