**Re: EB-2025-0297 Application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. and DNNP LP by its general partner, DNNP GP Inc., (together, the “Applicants”) for an order or orders relating to payment amounts for prescribed generating facilities (the “Application”) – Scheduled Motions Day**

Procedural Order No. 2 provided placeholders for motions days to resolve disputes that may arise before the technical conference and settlement conference. The first of these sessions, if required, was scheduled for April 28, 2026. On April 17, 2026, the OEB provided further direction with respect to the motions day, including that parties who plan to argue a motion are to file a letter with the OEB explaining the motion with a brief rationale by April 24, 2026. Given that interrogatory responses are scheduled to be filed on April 22, 2026 and April 24, 2026 for a late intervention, the Applicants do not believe that the currently scheduled motions day allows sufficient time for the Applicants and intervenors to meaningfully prepare for the session and participate.

Furthermore, it is not yet clear whether the motions will be heard virtually or in person. As the OEB is aware, the Applicants need sufficient time to make security-related arrangements for the motions hearing if it is to occur in-person. Security is needed in the hearing room and other areas to be frequented by OPG’s employees, and advanced confirmation of the hearing forum is therefore required to ensure those arrangements can be made.

In light of the forgoing, and to ensure efficiency in the hearing process, the Applicants request a later date for the motions day that continues to be sufficiently in advance of the Technical Conference commencing May 27, 2026, but allows all parties to fully prepare for the motions day. The Applicants propose that the motions day be scheduled during the week of May 11, 2026. This timing does not prejudice any party and does not require any other changes to the existing schedule laid out in EB-2025-0297 Procedural Order No. 2, Schedule C.
