**Subject:** RE: EB-2025-0297 - SEC Correspondence re Motions Day

Mr. Murray,

We are counsel to the School Energy Coalition (“SEC”). SEC does not object to the request by OPG for a delay of the first Motions Hearing, assuming it would similarly involve a delay in the date for required intervenors' letters seeking relief. SEC does agree with AMPCO that since there are only two days between the receipt of interrogatory responses and the deadline for filing the required letter, intervenors will be challenged to properly review the responses and determine if they should bring a motion at this stage in the proceeding.

SEC does request that OPG confirm that if its request is granted, it will still be in a position to provide responses to any disputed interrogatories in advance of the Technical Conference, if a

response is ordered by the OEB.

If the OEB does approve OPG's request to postpone the Motions Hearing to the week of May 11, we ask that it not be scheduled for the 12th, as the undersigned has a pre-existing commitment that day.
