Re: EB-2025-0297 Application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. and DNNP LP by its general partner, DNNP GP Inc., (together, the “Applicants”) for an order or orders relating to payment amounts for prescribed generating facilities (the “Application”) – Further Correspondence Regarding Scheduled Motions Day

Following up on the Applicants’ letter submitted on April 21, 2026, about scheduling the first motions day in this matter, I am writing to briefly address the correspondences filed by Mr. Pinto, AMPCO and SEC.

The Applicants’ primary reason for the scheduling request is that the current scheduled day of April 28th, 2026 does not provide sufficient time for parties to prepare for the motions session - a consideration that was echoed by AMPCO and SEC in their correspondence. The Applicants also believe that extending the schedule to allow some time between the service of motion materials and the motions day will be helpful in giving parties an opportunity to resolve or narrow the scope of certain motions, potentially leading to a more efficient motions day.

Depending on the outcome of the OEB’s decision following motions hearing, and total volume and effort associated with any required responses, the Applicants will make best efforts to file any revised responses before the Technical Conference.
