Ontario Energy Board (OEB) File Number: EB-2025-0297**

In Procedural Order No. 2, issued March 4, 2026, the OEB made provision, if needed, for a Motions Hearing scheduled for April 28, 2026. On April 17, 2026, the OEB directed parties that plan to argue a motion at this hearing to file a letter explaining the subject and rationale for the motion by April 24, 2026.

On April 21, 2026, the Applicants requested that the OEB reschedule the Motions Hearing. The Applicants submitted that the current schedule does not provide sufficient time for parties to adequately prepare for the Motions Hearing. The Applicants also submitted that extending the schedule to allow time between the service of motion materials and the Motions Hearing would be helpful in providing parties with an opportunity to resolve or narrow the scope of certain motions in advance, which could lead to a more efficient Motions Hearing.

Mr. Pinto objected to the request, while the Association of Major Power Consumers of Ontario and the School Energy Coalition echoed the Applicants' concern around timing. On April 22, 2026, the Applicants responded to the comments from Mr. Pinto, the Association of Major Power Consumers of Ontario, and the School Energy Coalition.

The OEB has determined that the Motions Hearing scheduled for April 28, 2026 will be rescheduled to **May 5, 2026**. Intervenors and OEB staff intending to bring a motion are required to file with the OEB, and serve on all other parties and OEB staff, by **April 27, 2026**, a letter explaining the subject and rationale of the proposed motion. The **April 28, 2026** date will instead be used as an "interrogatory resolution day" to provide parties with an opportunity to informally discuss and attempt to resolve any motion-related issues without the panel of Commissioners in attendance.

Both the April 28 interrogatory resolution day and the May 5 Motions Hearing will be held virtually and additional information regarding participation will be provided in due course.
