We write to advise the OEB that we will be delayed in filing Grant Lake's evidence.


In Procedural Order No. 4, issued Thursday April 16th, Grant Lake was given just over a week to file its evidence, which is due today. While at the time I expected that we would be able to comply with that time line, an intervening personal medical circumstance has taken a considerable amount of my time this week to address, and as a result we will be delayed in finalizing Grant Lake's evidence.

We have advised the Applicant of this circumstance through counsel, and the Applicant has graciously indicated that it will not object to a delay in filing until Monday (April 27th). We will make every effort to file that evidence as soon as possible, and are targeting Monday.

We also indicated to counsel that we will certainly accept a concomitant delay in filing of any interrogatories from the Applicant on the Grant Lake evidence. Despite any such reasonable delay we will make every effort to respond to any such interrogatories by the currently directed response date (May 8th).
