



**Enbridge Gas Inc.**

**Application to change its natural gas rates and other  
charges beginning January 1, 2024**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 6**

**April 28, 2026**

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application on October 31, 2022 with the OEB under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Enbridge Gas charges for natural gas distribution, transportation and storage, beginning January 1, 2024. The OEB is currently reviewing the third of the three phases of the application.

On March 26, 2026, the OEB issued its Decision on the Settlement Proposal and Rate Order which addressed all the ratemaking matters for Phase 3. On April 21, 2026, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 5 establishing a process to address the non-ratemaking matters for Phase 3.

The OEB is establishing a process for final cost awards covering the period up to and including February 17, 2026, which is the conclusion of the Settlement Proposal Presentation Day. The dates are set out below.

The OEB will establish a separate cost awards process for the period following February 17, 2026, at the conclusion of the proceeding.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

**THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:**

1. Cost eligible intervenors shall file their cost claims for costs incurred to the end of the Settlement Proposal Presentation Day on February 17, 2026 with the OEB and forward them to Enbridge Gas by **May 12, 2026**. Cost claims must be prepared in accordance with the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.
2. Enbridge Gas shall file with the OEB and forward to intervenors any objections to the claimed costs by **May 22, 2026**.

3. Intervenors to which Enbridge Gas filed an objection to the claimed costs, shall file with the OEB and forward to Enbridge Gas any responses to the objections for cost claims by **May 29, 2026**.
4. Enbridge Gas shall pay the OEB's costs of and incidental to this proceeding upon receipt of the OEB's invoice.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#).
