Grant Lake Evidence Filing: Update

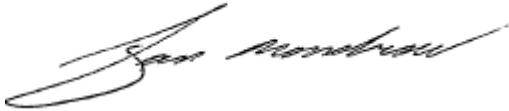
On April 24th we wrote to advise the OEB that we would be delayed in filing Grant Lake's evidence. Our April 24th letter indicated that we would make every effort to file that evidence as soon as possible, and that we were targeting yesterday - Monday (April 27th). Our letter further advised that the Applicant, through counsel, had indicated that the Applicant would not object to a delay in filing until yesterday (April 27th).

While our delay in finalizing Grant Lake's evidence for filing on April 24th was the result of a medical circumstance affecting the writer during the week provided in Procedural Order No. 4 for Grant Lake to file its evidence, at the same time the parties have been working on a consensual path forward to try to resolve the matters between them. Those discussions have continued over the past few days.

We are authorized to advise that the Applicant supports a further delay in the filing of Grant Lake's evidence, in the interim until tomorrow, and that the parties expect to provide more details to the OEB tomorrow on their proposed path forward, including disposition of the balance of the procedural dates directed herein including the date for filing of Grant Lake evidence.

In the interim, we trust that this update is of some assistance.
