



Ontario Power Generation Inc. and DNNP LP

**Application for payment amounts for the period from
January 1, 2027 to December 31, 2031**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 5
May 1, 2026**

On April 28, 2026, the Applicants requested the OEB's approval to (i) permanently redact from the public record information that is non-relevant and/or (ii) treat as confidential, certain information included in the Application.

Requests for Permanent Redaction

The Applicants made seven requests for permanent redaction, as follows:

1. Personal Information (L-D2-SEC-064 Attachment 21 pp.70-71)
2. Personal Information (L-D2-SEC-094 Attachment 2 pp.1-4)
3. Personal Information (L-D2-SEC-110 Attachment 1 pp.12-14)
4. Personal Information (L-D2-SEC-116 Attachment 14 pp.70-71)
5. Non-relevant information consisting of forward-looking commercial information related to OPG's unregulated subsidiaries engaged in competitive business activity, and OPG's unregulated business (L-A2-Staff-016 Attachment 1 pp. 2, 4, 5)
6. Non-relevant phone numbers of OPG and other employees included in the DNNP Grid Connection Project Management Plan (L-D2-AMPCO-088 Attachment 7 pp. 22-23)
7. Non-relevant superseded estimates (L-D2-Staff-117, Attachment 2 pp. 33, 35-40)

The OEB has reviewed the requests and approves the requests for permanent redactions with the exception of #5 for which confidential treatment is approved.

The OEB finds the redactions in requests #1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 are related to non-relevant information and should be permanently redacted. In accordance with the Practice Direction on Confidential Filings (Practice Direction) Part 11,¹ the OEB finds that the

redacted information is not relevant and will not assist the OEB with any of the issues to be decided in this proceeding.

The OEB finds the redactions in request #7 are related to comparisons between Class 3 and Class 4 estimates. As the Class 4 estimate has been superseded by the Class 3 estimate, and the Class 3 estimate is part of the evidentiary record that remains on the public record, the OEB finds the Class 4 estimate is not relevant to the OEB's consideration of the issues in this proceeding and consistent with the Practice Direction Part 11.

The OEB finds the redactions in request #5 may be relevant to intervenors and the OEB's consideration of the proposed capital structure, an approved issue in this proceeding. The OEB does not agree with the Applicants' submission that similar information was approved by the OEB in this proceeding for permanent redaction. The redactions in request #5 relate to the Darlington New Nuclear Program (DNNP) and could have implications on OPG's regulated operations. The OEB approves confidential treatment of the redactions to request #5 for the forward-looking commercial information that does not appear to be publicly available.

Requests for Confidential Treatment

Intervenors and OEB staff may file objections by **June 10, 2026**, and the Applicants may file a reply by **June 24, 2026**. The OEB notes that under the above timelines, a decision regarding the Applicants' requests for confidentiality will not be issued prior to the Technical Conference, scheduled to begin May 27, 2026. As a result, any discussions at the Technical Conference related to the information the Applicants have requested to be confidential will be conducted in camera, involving only those parties who have signed and submitted a Declaration and Undertaking.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. The Applicants' request for permanent redactions is granted in respect of the documents identified as items #1-4, 6, and 7. To clarify, where confidential treatment and permanent redactions have been granted in the same document, permanent redactions should remain redacted even for those who have provided a Declaration and Undertaking.
2. The Applicants shall provide individuals who have signed and filed a Declaration and Undertaking with the non-redacted, confidential version of the document identified as item #5 by **May 15, 2026**.

3. Intervenors and OEB staff shall file any objections to the Applicants' requests for confidential treatment with the OEB and serve them on all other parties by **June 10, 2026**.
4. The Applicants shall file a reply submission with the OEB and serve it on all parties by **June 24, 2026**.
