## OVERVIEW

On August 28, 2025, Entegrus Powerlines Inc. (Entegrus Powerlines) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* seeking approval for changes to the rates that Entegrus Powerlines charges for electricity distribution, beginning May 1, 2026.

On October 14, 2025, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1, granting intervenor status and cost eligibility to School Energy Coalition (SEC), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC).

On March 19, 2026, the OEB issued its Decision and Rate Order, detailing the process for filing cost claims. Cost-eligible intervenors were required to submit their cost claims by April 2, 2026.

The OEB received cost claims from both SEC and VECC. No objections were raised by Entegrus Powerlines.

## Findings

The OEB has reviewed the cost claims to ensure compliance with its [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#).

The OEB finds that the cost claims are reasonable and shall be reimbursed by Entegrus Powerlines.

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Entegrus Powerlines Inc. shall immediately pay the following amounts to the intervenors for their costs:
