Elexicon is filing responses to all the interrogatories (“IRs”) that it received on April 10, 2026, with several exceptions as noted below.

- **Responses to IRs related to the April 2 Evidence Update:** On April 2, 2026, Elexicon filed an evidence update with a revised version of Exhibit 9, and a new Exhibit 10 with updated evidence regarding its Control Centre OM&A segment, and Benefit Cost Analyses (BCAs) related to its Non-Wires Solutions Framework (the “Evidence Update”). The PO established a separate round of interrogatories related to the Evidence Update. However, several parties submitted IRs related to this evidence in the first round. In accordance with the PO, Elexicon will file response to these IRs by May 27, 2026: 10-SEC-102, 10-SEC-103, 9-CCC-66, 10-CCC-71, 4-Staff-115 and 4-Staff 118(d), 6-SEC-88, 9-SEC-98, 6-Staff-150, 9-Staff-162(b) and (c), 9-Staff-168, 9-Staff-171, 9-Staff-180.
- **Responses to IRs related to AMI2.0:** In early April, Elexicon underwent an SAP implementation as part of its Dx NEXT initiative which involved wholesale replacement of its customer information system (“CIS”), the timing of which coincided with Elexicon’s first round of IRs. The internal resources responsible for the implementation of this new CIS were also responsible for responding to IRs related to AMI 2.0. As such, the following IR responses could not be completed in the time allotted and will be filed by May 27, 2026: 2B-SEC-60, 2-CCC-23, 4-CCC-47(g) and 4-CCC-49(b)
- **Responses to IRs requesting capital-related information dating back to the rebasing of legacy utilities (i.e. 2011 for Whitby Hydro, and 2014 for Veridian).** Given the length of the historical period contemplated by these IRs, Elexicon requires additional time to conduct further due diligence on available historical information prior to providing its best-efforts responses to these IRs which will be filed by May 27, 2026: 2B-SEC-33, 2B-SEC-36, 2-Staff-77, 2-Staff-83.
