



**Elexicon Energy Inc.**

**Application for electricity distribution rates and other  
charges beginning January 1, 2027**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2  
May 15, 2026**

Elexicon Energy Inc. (Elexicon Energy) filed a cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on December 19, 2025 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* seeking approval for changes to the rates that Elexicon Energy charges for electricity distribution, beginning January 1, 2027, and for each following year through to December 31, 2031.

**Confidentiality Request**

By [letter](#) dated May 8, 2026, Elexicon Energy requested confidential treatment and/or permanent redaction of certain interrogatory responses on the basis that they contain confidential, irrelevant, or personal information as defined in OEB's [Practice Direction on Confidential Filings](#) (Practice Direction).

Not all of Elexicon Energy's requests fall within the presumptive categories of confidential information outlined in Appendix B of the Practice Direction.

Under section 5.1.6 of the Practice Direction, parties and OEB staff have five business days to file an objection to a confidentiality request, unless otherwise directed by the OEB. Under section 5.1.8, the party making the confidentiality request will then have five business days to file its reply to any objections. Based on the date of Elexicon Energy's filing, any objections would be due by May 15, 2026, and any reply by Elexicon Energy would be due by May 25, 2026.

Given the volume of material to which Elexicon Energy's confidentiality requests relate, the OEB finds it appropriate to extend the timelines for submissions from OEB staff and all parties on the confidentiality request.

Accordingly, the OEB directs that any objection by OEB staff or intervenors to Elexicon Energy's confidentiality request of May 8, 2026, shall be filed by **May 22, 2026**. The OEB also directs that if Elexicon Energy wishes to respond to any objections, it shall file its reply submission by **May 29, 2026**.

## Extension Request for Outstanding Responses to First-Round Interrogatories

Elexicon Energy's responses to interrogatories were due by May 8, 2026. In its May 8, 2026 [cover letter](#) to its interrogatory responses, Elexicon Energy identified three categories of interrogatories for which additional time was required to provide responses: interrogatories related to the April 2, 2026 evidence update; interrogatories related to AMI 2.0; and interrogatories requesting capital-related information dating back to the rebasing of the legacy utilities. Elexicon Energy indicated that it would file responses to these interrogatories by May 27, 2026.

The OEB will treat Elexicon Energy's statements as a request for an extension to the OEB's filing deadline. The OEB grants the extension. Elexicon Energy shall file the outstanding interrogatory responses identified in its May 8, 2026 cover letter by **May 27, 2026**.

## Motions Hearing

Due to a scheduling conflict with another OEB proceeding, the OEB is rescheduling the transcribed virtual motions hearing, in the event that such a hearing is necessary. The virtual motions hearing is being rescheduled to **July 9, 2026** from its formerly scheduled date of July 13, 2026. The purpose of this hearing is to provide an opportunity for the OEB to address any motions that may be filed with respect to interrogatory responses, technical conference undertaking responses, or other matters.

All other dates established in Procedural Order No. 1 remain unchanged.

The OEB is making provisions for the following related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

## THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

### Confidential Filings

1. OEB staff and intervenors who wish to file an objection to Elexicon Energy Inc.'s May 8, 2026, confidentiality request shall file a written submission with the OEB and serve it on all parties and OEB staff by **May 22, 2026**.
2. If Elexicon Energy Inc. wishes to respond to any objections, it shall file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on all parties and OEB staff by **May 29, 2026**.

## Interrogatories

3. Elexicon Energy Inc. shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the outstanding first-round interrogatories identified in its May 8, 2026, cover letter and serve them on all parties and OEB staff by **May 27, 2026**.

## Motions Hearing

4. If necessary, a transcribed virtual motions hearing will be held on **July 9, 2026**, starting at 9:30 a.m. to hear any motions that have been filed. Further information on how to participate will be communicated to parties closer to the date.

## Direction for preparing materials

- Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with Rule 9A of the OEB's [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#).
- Filings should clearly state the filing date and the sender's name, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address.
- Other than for applications or as otherwise required or directed by the OEB, parties are not required to submit a cover letter for materials that are self-evident (e.g., interrogatories, submissions) unless the cover letter includes a request or additional information not included in the materials themselves.
- Parties are strongly encouraged to use bookmarks in their filings to aid in navigation.
- Parties should not append to their evidence entire OEB documents (e.g., decisions, policy documents, guidelines). Rather, parties should provide citations to the documents and a clear and concise summary of the relevant part of the document. Parties are encouraged to use hyperlinks for complete, permanent, and publicly available versions of the documents, when possible.
- Parties should refrain from quoting material from documents unless it is essential to support their interrogatories or arguments.
- Parties are not required to provide a summary of the procedural history of a proceeding but may refer to that history where and to the extent needed for context to orient an issue or discussion.
- Parties must: (a) disclose where generative artificial intelligence was used to generate content included in a filing and (b) confirm that the accuracy of the portion of the filing generated by generative artificial intelligence has been

verified by the party or its representative without the assistance of generative artificial intelligence.

### How to file documents with the OEB

- Parties are required to quote file number **EB-2025-0312** for all materials filed and submit them in **searchable/unrestricted PDF format** (i.e., no printing or copying restrictions) with a digital signature through the [OEB's online filing portal](#).
- Parties should use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the [Regulatory Electronic Submission System \(RESS\) Document Guidelines](#) found at the [File documents online page](#) on the OEB's website.
- Parties are encouraged to use RESS. Those who have not yet [set up an account](#), or require assistance using the online filing portal can contact [registrar@oeb.ca](mailto:registrar@oeb.ca) for assistance.
- Cost claims are filed through the OEB's online filing portal. Parties are encouraged to visit the [File documents online page](#) of the OEB's website for more information. Parties that are eligible for a cost award and that do not currently have an account in the cost claim portal should create an account as soon as their cost award eligibility has been confirmed by the OEB. All parties shall download a copy of their submitted cost claim for the purposes of service on the party(ies) paying cost awards as per the [Practice Direction on Cost Awards](#). All communications should be directed to the attention of the Registrar and be received by **4:45 p.m.** on the required date.
