Issues:

Members and supporters of Energy Probe are customers of Toronto Hydro. The rates they pay will be impacted by the outcome of this proceeding. Energy Probe is concerned by the risks that the proposed NWS plan will pose for all customers, and particularly those that will enter into contracts with NWS aggregators.

Policy Interests:

Although Energy Probe has no policy interest in this proceeding it is concerned that this proceeding may set a policy direction for similar applications by other electricity distributors. Energy Probe believes that the OEB should ensure that there is adequate policy protection for customers in their dealings with NWS aggregators.

Hearings:

Normally Energy Probe prefers a written hearing in order to minimize regulatory costs. In this case, however, after reading public comments posted on the OEB website, Energy Probe believes that there is a good reason for having an oral hearing. This seems to be a controversial application which is opposed by many members of the public. An oral hearing is likely to better deal with public concerns than a written hearing.

Evidence:

Energy Probe does not intend to file evidence in the proceeding.

Coordination with Other Intervenors:

Energy Probe intends to coordinate its efforts with intervenors with similar interests by sharing plans for interrogatories, technical conference, and the hearing to avoid duplication.

Cost Awards:

Energy Probe applies for recovery of its reasonably incurred costs during its intervention in this proceeding. Energy Probe is a non-profit organization which relies on individual donations to help protect the public interest. Without the prospect of an award of costs, Energy Probe's ability to participate in OEB proceedings would be limited. Energy Probe's members and supporters are customers of Toronto Hydro and are eligible for an award of costs according to section 3.03(a) of the Practice Directions. Energy Probe has participated in many past natural gas and electricity proceedings in Ontario, including consultations, rate cases, and other processes and hearings, and has been found eligible to be paid its reasonably incurred costs.

Language Preference:

Energy Probe does not intend to participate using the French language.
