Party Experts to Attend the Technical Conference

In accordance with Procedural Order No. 2, dated March 4, 2026, below is CCC's preliminary time estimate for the Technical Conference in OPG's 2027-2031 payment amounts proceeding. Please note that our review is ongoing and the time estimates set out below are subject to change.

OEB staff circulated a witness panel list on May 19, 2026. The witness panel list does not include any of OPG's third-party experts. CCC expects that it will have questions for Concentric, London Economics International (LEI) and ScottMadden. We understand that other intervenors may also have questions for the above noted third-party experts, and for Willis Towers Watson (WTW). We believe that the most effective and efficient process is to allow intervenors to ask their questions directly to these experts at the technical conference. The studies developed by these experts are complicated and we would achieve the best understanding of the methodologies applied, and conclusions drawn, through a detailed discussion of certain models and related interrogatory responses at the technical conference. In addition, the issues addressed by these third-party experts (i.e., equity thickness, hydroelectric incentive ratemaking framework inputs, nuclear benchmarking, and compensation) are material.

On this basis, we have requested that OPG make these third-party experts available for questions at the technical conference. However, we have been unable to resolve this matter with OPG directly. Therefore, we request that the OEB direct OPG to include

Concentric, LEI, ScottMadden, and WTW on the relevant witness panels (or, separately, if that is preferable to the Company).

We have included CCC's preliminary time estimates for the various third-party experts in the table below. We may need to adjust our time estimates for the other witness panels if the third-party experts are not made available for questions at the technical conference.
