**Re: EB-2025-0295: Enbridge Gas Inc. (EGI) Application for Multi-Year Natural Gas Demand Side Management Plan (2027-2030)**

**Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA) Evidence Response**

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In our letter of May 12<sup>th</sup> we indicated that following the interrogatory process IGUA will consider whether additional “industry evidence” could and should be brought forward to support IGUA’s position in favour of the proposed opt-out proposal and assist the OEB in its deliberations thereon.

EGI in its response to intervenor evidence proposals (letter dated May 19<sup>th</sup>) indicated it does not oppose the introduction of evidence as proposed by IGUA, but was concerned about uncertainty regarding timing. OEB Staff has indicated its view that IGUA’s request regarding evidence is reasonable and would be useful and a natural extension of pre-application discussions previously directed by the Board, and that “*timing concerns could be addressed by aligning any evidence filing with the schedule for other intervenor evidence*”.

To clarify, we assumed that:

1. Our letter of May 12<sup>th</sup> was IGUA’s request for OEB approval to file evidence. (That is, we did not intend to suggest that there would be any further request.)
2. Should IGUA elect to proceed to file evidence following review of EGI’s responses to interrogatories, providing that the OEB so allows, we would do so on the same schedule as any other intervenor evidence is directed to be filed.

We trust that this clarification is of assistance.
