



Enbridge Gas Inc.

**Application for exemption from leave to construct
natural gas pipeline and associated facilities in the
Town of Caledon**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 3
May 28, 2026**

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on September 29, 2025, under subsection 95(2) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, (OEB Act) for an order exempting Enbridge Gas from the requirement to obtain leave to construct natural gas pipelines and facilities in the Town of Caledon near the intersection of Humber Station Road and Old Church Road, Ontario (Application).

Procedural Order No. 1 was issued on December 18, 2025, setting the schedule for written discovery on Enbridge Gas's evidence. OEB staff filed interrogatories on January 30, 2026, and Enbridge Gas filed interrogatory responses on February 13, 2026, each in accordance with the dates set in Procedural Order No. 1.

Procedural order No. 2 was issued on February 25, 2026, providing for submission from OEB staff and reply submission from Enbridge Gas.

On March 12, 2026, OEB Staff filed a letter, requesting that the Application be placed into abeyance until the Ministry of Energy and Mine's (Ministry) Letter of Opinion is filed.

On March 13, 2026, the OEB issued a letter placing the Application into abeyance until the earlier of April 27, 2026 or when the Ministry's Letter of Option is filed to the OEB. On April 28, 2026, the OEB issued a letter extending the abeyance until May 27, 2026.

As the abeyance period has now ended, the OEB will take the proceeding out of abeyance effective May 28, 2026 and, for reasons of regulatory efficiency, will continue with the next steps in the proceeding.

By way of this procedural order, the OEB will provide an updated schedule for submissions from OEB staff, as well as for a reply submission from Enbridge Gas.

Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. OEB staff shall file any written submissions with the OEB and serve them on all parties by **June 18, 2026**.
2. Enbridge Gas shall file a written reply submission, if any, with the OEB and serve it on all parties, by **July 3, 2026**.

Parties are responsible for ensuring that any documents they file with the OEB, such as applicant and intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses to interrogatories or any other type of document, **do not include personal information** (as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*), unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#).
