LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Eryn Mackinnon:

**Re: Hydro One Networks Inc. (HONI)
Leave to Construct Application – D6 Relocation Project
Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2026-0112**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for HONI's Leave to Construct Application – D6 Relocation Project (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 to 3 below prior to **June 11, 2026**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at registrar@oeb.ca.

You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed construction of the transmission line and related facilities.
2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on HONI's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of the enclosed Notice and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
 - a. All property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1
 - b. All electricity distributors in whose service areas the proposed transmission line and related facilities will be located

- c. All generators impacted by the proposed transmission line and related facilities
 - d. All transmission customers of HONI impacted by the proposed transmission line and related facilities
 - e. All owners and operators of rail lines, telecommunications (e.g., telephone) or other utilities along or crossing the route and location for the proposed transmission line and related facilities will connect
 - f. The clerk of the County of Renfrew
 - g. The clerks of the Towns of Petawawa, Laurentian Hills and Deep River
 - h. The following government ministries and agencies:
 - i. Ministry of Energy and Mines
 - ii. Ministry of Infrastructure
 - iii. Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks
 - iv. Ministry of Natural Resources
 - v. Ministry of Indigenous Affairs and First Nations Economic Reconciliation
 - vi. Ministry of Transportation
 - vii. Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing
 - viii. Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism
 - ix. Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Agribusiness
 - x. Ministry of Infrastructure
 - xi. Electrical Safety Authority
 - xii. Independent Electricity System Operator
 - i. The following federal government departments:
 - i. Transport Canada
 - ii. Indigenous Services Canada
- (Note: It is acceptable to serve the evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)
- 3. To post the enclosed Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, on HONI's website.
 - 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the relevant Notice and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices.
 - 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
