DECISION AND ORDER

Dynasty Power Inc. filed an application on April 13, 2026, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence EW-2021-0132, which is set to expire on June 9, 2026.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity wholesaler licence to Dynasty Power Inc.

For the purposes of any future licencing-related activities, the OEB reminds the applicant that the OEB's performance standard for a typical licence renewal application provides for a total cycle time of 90 days. This duration enables the OEB to undertake necessary review and administrative steps to issue a licence prior to the expiry of the existing one at a pace that also accommodates its overall licencing-related caseload volumes.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
