Re: Notice of Motion filed by BFN Transmission GP Holding Company Inc.

On May 5, 2026, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued Procedural Order No. 5 in this proceeding, which allowed the intervenor Grant Lake Resources Ltd. and Josephine Forest Resources Ltd. (Grant Lake) to file any evidence that is relevant to the proceeding by June 1, 2026. Procedural Order No. 5 also set out dates for the filing of interrogatories on Grant Lake's evidence, and dates for the filing of final submissions.

On June 1, Grant Lake filed its evidence. On June 3, BFN Transmission GP Holding Company Inc. (BFN) filed a notice of motion (Motion) asking the OEB to strike the evidence filed by Grant Lake from the record of this proceeding. The Motion states that Grant Lake's evidence is irrelevant, out of scope and/or inadmissible as improperly disclosing settlement discussions between the parties with respect to compensation.

Although the OEB appreciates BFN's concerns regarding Grant Lake's evidence, it has determined that as a matter of procedural efficiency it will continue with the existing procedural schedule as set out in Procedural Order No. 5. The OEB will hear the motion through the final submissions of the parties, and make a determination on the treatment of the Grant Lake evidence through its final decision.

BFN also seeks to recover its costs for the Motion from Grant Lake. The OEB will make a determination on costs through the cost awards process at the end of the proceeding, where it will consider, amongst other things, the relevance of materials filed by the parties.
