AFFIDAVIT OF ERYN MACKINNON

I, Eryn MacKinnon, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:

1. I am employed as a Regulatory Advisor in the Regulatory Affairs Division of the Applicant, Hydro One Networks Inc.
2. Hydro One has complied with the Ontario Energy Board’s (“**OEB**”) Letter of Direction dated June 22, 2026, in respect of EB-2026-0018 (**the “Letter”**) as set out below.
3. In accordance with paragraph 1 of the Letter, Hydro One conducted a title search sufficient to determine the registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interests directly affected by the proposed application and related facilities refurbishments. I have been advised and do truly believe that this search has been completed as required.
4. In accordance with paragraph 2, subsection (a) of the Letter, Hydro One served the encumbrancers identified as having lands or interests directly affected by the proposed facilities refurbishments. The Notice package was delivered by courier and included a copy of the OEB’s English Notice, as well as the Application. A copy of the Notice package as sent to the described parties is attached at **Exhibit “A”**. A copy of the courier manifest is attached at **Exhibit “B”**.

5. In accordance with paragraph 2, subsections (b) through (i) of the Letter, an electronic copy of the Notice and the Application (Exhibit “A”) was served on the following:

- Identified electricity distributors whose service area the proposed transmission line and related facilities will be located;
- Hydro One transmission customers and generators impacted by the proposed refurbishment of the transmission line and related facilities;
- Owners and operators of rail lines, telecommunications networks, and other utilities along or crossing the proposed route and location for the Project;
- The clerks for the City of Ottawa
- All indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed upgrade and construction of the transmission line and related facilities;
- All specified provincial ministries, agencies, and federal departments.

Copies of the email correspondence are attached at **Exhibit “C”**.

6. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the Letter, the English version of the Notice, the Application, and the Evidence were posted on Hydro One’s website on June 23, 2026. A copy of the website posting is attached at **Exhibit “D”**.

NOTICE OF A HEARING

Hydro One Networks Inc. has applied for approval to construct a high-voltage transmission line in the City of Ottawa

Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One Networks) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for an order granting leave to construct approximately 11 kilometres of new transmission line and associated facilities between Hawthorne Transformer Station and Orléans Transformer Station in the City of Ottawa (Project). The Project would primarily be located within an existing transmission corridor. The Project would consist of approximately ten kilometres of 115 kilovolt single-circuit transmission line and one kilometre of 230 kilovolt transmission line.

Hydro One Networks is also asking the OEB to approve the forms of land use agreements that Hydro One Networks will offer to affected landowners.

Hydro One Networks submits that the transmission line and associated facilities are required to ensure sufficient supply capacity to meet growing electricity needs in the Orleans area driven by long-term development and electrification trends.

Hydro One Networks submits that the Project is not expected to have a material impact on a typical residential customer’s bill, nor does the Independent Electricity System Operator expect the Project to have any material adverse impact the reliability of the integrated power system.

The OEB hearing is not the only approval process required before a line is built. Environmental issues, or issues related to the Crown’s duty to consult Indigenous peoples, are not part of the OEB’s review unless there is a direct impact on price and the reliability and quality of electricity service.

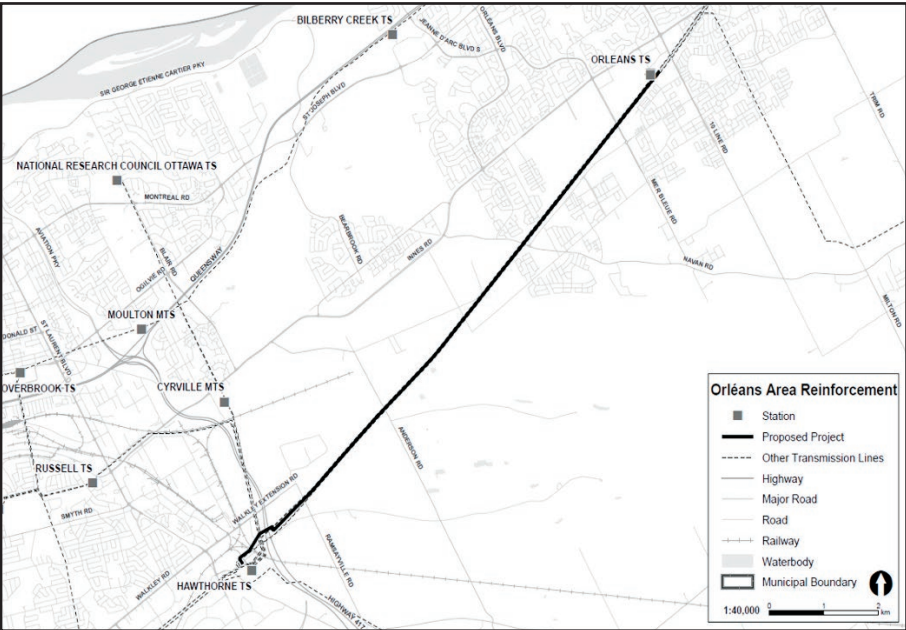

AVIS D'AUDIENCE

Hydro One Networks Inc. a demandé l'autorisation de construire une ligne de transport à haute tension dans la ville d'Ottawa

Hydro One Networks Inc. (Hydro One Networks) a demandé à la Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario (CEO) une ordonnance accordant l'autorisation de construire environ 11 kilomètres de nouvelle ligne de transport et des installations connexes entre le poste de transformation Hawthorne et le poste de transformation d'Orléans dans la ville d'Ottawa (ci-après le « projet »). Le projet serait principalement situé dans un couloir de transport existant. Le projet comprendrait environ dix kilomètres de ligne de transport à circuit unique de 115 kilovolts et un kilomètre de ligne de transport de 230 kilovolts.

Hydro One Networks demande également à la CEO d'approuver les formes d'ententes d'utilisation du sol qu'elle offrira aux propriétaires fonciers touchés.

Hydro One Networks soutient que la ligne de transport et les installations connexes sont nécessaires pour assurer une capacité d'approvisionnement suffisante afin de répondre aux besoins croissants en électricité dans la région d'Orléans, stimulés par les tendances à long terme en matière de développement et d'électrification.

Hydro One Networks soutient que le projet ne devrait pas avoir d'incidence importante sur la facture d'un client résidentiel typique, et la Société indépendante d'exploitation du réseau d'électricité ne s'attend pas non plus à ce que le projet ait une incidence négative importante sur la fiabilité du réseau électrique intégré.

En plus de l'audience de la CEO, d'autres processus sont requis avant de pouvoir construire une ligne. Les questions environnementales ou les questions liées à l'obligation de la Couronne de consulter les peuples autochtones ne font pas partie de l'examen de la CEO, à moins qu'elles n'aient une incidence directe sur le prix et sur la fiabilité et la qualité du service d'électricité.

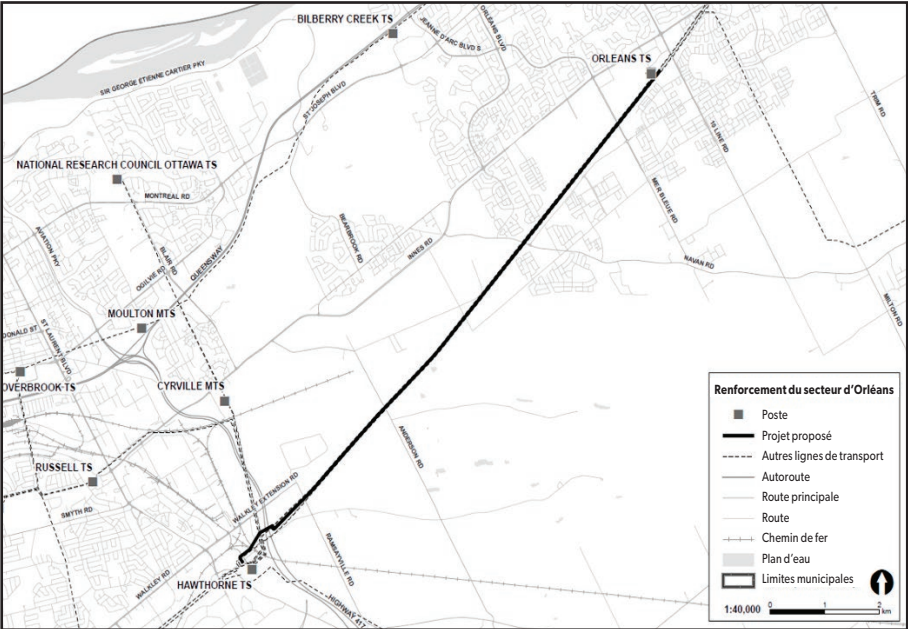

IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998,
c. 15, Schedule B (the “**Act**”);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Hydro One Networks Inc.
 (“**Hydro One**”) pursuant to section 92 of the Act for an Order or Orders
granting leave to construct transmission line facilities (“**Orléans Area
Reinforcement Project**” or “**Project**”) in the Orleans area of Ottawa;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Hydro One pursuant to
section 97 of the Act for an Order granting approval of the forms of
land use agreements offered or to be offered to affected landowners.

APPLICATION

1. The Applicant is Hydro One, a subsidiary of Hydro One Inc. The Applicant is an Ontario corporation with its head office in the City of Toronto. Hydro One carries on the business, among other things, of owning and operating transmission facilities within Ontario.
2. Hydro One hereby applies to the OEB pursuant to section 92 of the Act for an Order or Orders granting leave to construct a new 115 kV single-circuit transmission line, approximately 10 km in length, between Hawthorne TS and Orleans TS primarily within an existing transmission corridor in the Orleans area. As part of the Project, Hydro One will also construct an approximately 1 km section of 230 kV transmission line to connect into Hawthorne TS, which will enable the existing 115 kV single-circuit transmission line (H9A) to be reconfigured to operate at its rated 230 kV voltage and thereby provide the additional 230 kV supply capacity needed in the Orleans area. The total length of all transmission line facilities is approximately 11 km.

- 1 3. The Project is required to ensure sufficient 115 kV and 230 kV supply capacity to
2 meet the growing electricity needs in the Orleans area in accordance with the
3 recommendations from the regional planning process provided in **Exhibit H, Tab 1,**
4 **Schedule 1.** The IESO further reaffirmed the need for the Project in their
5 supplemental evidence provided for the purposes of this Application in **Attachment**
6 **1 of Exhibit B, Tab 3, Schedule 1.** The Project also aligns with Ontario's Integrated
7 Energy Plan¹ which emphasizes the importance of taking action to ensure that the
8 demand growth in eastern Ontario is not constrained by transmission capacity. Given
9 the above, the Project has been identified as a non-discretionary development project
10 in **Exhibit B, Tab 4, Schedule 1.**
- 11
- 12 4. An overview map of the area is provided in **Exhibit B, Tab 2, Schedule 1,**
13 **Attachment 1,** and schematic diagrams of the proposed Project can be found at
14 **Exhibit B, Tab 2, Schedule 1, Attachments 2 to 4.**
- 15
- 16 5. The forecast total capital cost of the Project transmission facilities is \$99.9 million².
17 Details pertaining to these costs are provided at **Exhibit B, Tab 7, Schedule 1.**
- 18
- 19 6. The Project is not expected to have a material change in a typical residential
20 customer's bill under the RPP (i.e., \$0.01 per year using the 2026 OEB-approved
21 Uniform Transmission Rates) as filed in **Exhibit B, Tab 9, Schedule 1.**
- 22
- 23 7. The 115 kV conductor selected by Hydro One to complete the Project has been
24 predicated on Hydro One's commitment to minimize transmission line losses where
25 feasible. Further information regarding the transmission line loss analysis for this
26 Project is provided in **Exhibit B, Tab 5, Schedule 1.**

- 1 8. The IESO has completed a Draft SIA. The final version is expected from the IESO
2 shortly and will be filed upon receipt. The Draft SIA concludes that the Project is
3 expected to have no material adverse impact on the reliability of the integrated power
4 system and recommends that a *Notification of Conditional Approval for Connection*
5 be issued. The IESO's Draft SIA is provided as **Exhibit F, Tab 1, Schedule 1,**
6 **Attachment 1.**
7
- 8 9. Hydro One has completed a Draft CIA in accordance with Hydro One's connection
9 procedures. A copy of the Draft CIA is provided as **Exhibit G, Tab 1, Schedule 1,**
10 **Attachment 1.** The final version is expected to be completed shortly and will be filed
11 upon completion. Hydro One will fulfill all requirements of the SIA and the CIA, and
12 will obtain all necessary approvals, permits, licences, certificates, agreements, and
13 rights required to construct the Project.
14
- 15 10. The Project is subject to the applicable Class EA process in accordance with the
16 *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*. On April 2, 2026, Hydro One filed the Final
17 ESR³ and Statement of Completion with the MECP.
18
- 19 11. The proposed in-service date for the Project is September 2029, assuming a
20 construction commencement date of February 2027 and an OEB approval of this
21 Application by January 2027. A project schedule with the aforementioned
22 assumptions is provided at **Exhibit B, Tab 11, Schedule 1.**
23
- 24 12. New permanent land rights on properties between Hawthorne TS and Orleans TS will
25 be required to accommodate the proposed transmission line facilities. The Project will
26 require Hydro One to acquire land rights from 44 directly impacted properties.
27
- 28 13. Temporary rights for construction purposes will also be required at specific locations
29 along the corridor. These rights will be negotiated and acquired as and when needed.

Further information regarding the real estate needs to complete this project are provided in **Exhibit E, Tab 1, Schedule 1**.

14. This Application is also seeking approval of the forms of the agreement offered, or to be offered, to affected landowners pursuant to section 97 of the Act. All voluntary property rights agreements will be in the form of an option agreement, and Hydro One will exercise these options and conclude the land rights agreements once it has received the OEB's Leave to Construct approval of the Project. These agreements are substantively consistent with the forms of agreement previously approved in prior Hydro One leave to construct proceedings. Any minor alterations from their last approval, should there be any, have all been explicitly identified in the Application. The forms of the applied-for agreements are found as attachments to **Exhibit E, Tab 1, Schedule 1**.

15. The Application is supported by written evidence which includes details of the Applicant's proposal for the transmission line facilities. The written evidence is prefiled and may be amended from time to time prior to the OEB's final decision.

16. Acronyms and abbreviations are used throughout the evidence and those acronyms and abbreviations are defined at **Exhibit A, Tab 1, Schedule 3**.

17. Based on the foregoing, and the information provided in the prefiled evidence, Hydro One submits that the Project is in the public interest.

18. The relief requested herein is required to ensure sufficient 115 kV and 230 kV supply capacity to meet the growing electricity needs in the Orleans area driven by long-term development and electrification trends. The Project meets the supply capacity need of the transmission system in accordance with the recommendations from the regional planning process and in alignment with the Integrated Energy Plan's direction.

1 19. The Project will enable more efficient use of existing assets and address constraints
2 on the existing 115 kV system. By locating the new transmission line facilities within
3 an existing transmission corridor, the Project reduces its land use footprint and
4 minimizes impacts on both natural and socio-economic environments.

5
6 20. Furthermore, Hydro One is obligated to provide facilities required to maintain the
7 reliability and integrity of its transmission system and reinforce or expand its
8 transmission system as required to meet load growth in accordance with its
9 Transmission License and the TSC. This Project is needed in order for Hydro One to
10 satisfy this obligation.

11
12 21. Hydro One requests:

- 13 a) An Order or Orders pursuant to section 92 of the Act granting leave to construct
14 the Project;
15 b) An approval of the forms of the agreement offered, or to be offered, to affected
16 landowners pursuant to section 97 of the Act; and
17 c) Such other relief as Hydro One may request or as the Board may direct.

18
19 22. Hydro One consents to the conditions outlined in the OEB's standard conditions of
20 approval for electricity transmission leave to construct applications⁴ for the Project.
21 Furthermore, Hydro One consents to the OEB proceeding by way of a written hearing
22 for this proceeding.

23
24 23. Hydro One requests that a copy of all documents filed with the OEB be served on the
25 Applicant and the Applicant's counsel, as follows:

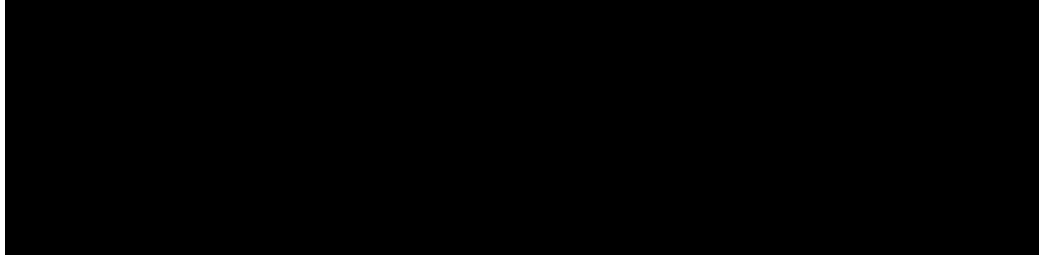
