Preamble:

In its decision for the EB-2017-0108 proceeding, the OEB granted Enbridge Gas and ECPOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (EPCOR), new certificates for Norfolk County. The new certificates cancelled and superseded Enbridge Gas's and EPCOR's existing certificates for Norfolk County.

Enbridge Gas states that its service area in Norfolk County has changed due to the OEB granting the following limited certificates:

- OM Limited Partnership - EB-2017-0289 (A&B)
- Metalore Resources Limited - EB-2019-0089
- Six Nations - EB-2021-0238
- Clearbeach Resources Inc - EB-2024-0239

Enbridge Gas has applied for an order granting a new certificate for Norfolk County to reflect its updated service area. A draft certificate is included in schedule E1 of the application. A track changed version is included in schedule E2.

Question(s):

- a) Please clarify whether the draft certificates included in the application include the area of Norfolk County granted to Clearbeach Resources Inc. If not, please file updated draft certificates that include the area in Norfolk County granted to Clearbeach Resources Inc.

Response:

- a) Enbridge Gas's draft Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for Norfolk County (Schedule E1 of the Application) excludes all areas within Norfolk County covered by CPCNs issued to other parties, including the CPCN granted to Clearbeach Resources Inc.

Page 3 of the application states the following: "The bolded text in the excerpt below from the EB-2021-0238-H CPCN describes an area within the jurisdiction of the County of Brant that is also identified in the CPCN granted to Enbridge Gas for the County of Brant (EB-2021-0238-G)"

Question(s):

- a) Please clarify whether the second reference to the County of Brant in the summary above should state County of Norfolk.

Response:

- a) No, the second reference to the County of Brant in paragraph 11 of the Application is correct; EB-2021-0238-G is the most recent CPCN the OEB granted to Enbridge Gas for the County of Brant. This paragraph describes how the EB-2021-0238-H CPCN (the most recent CPCN the OEB granted to Enbridge Gas for Norfolk County) erroneously includes a reference to an area under the jurisdiction of the County of Brant. Schedule E2 of the Application shows how the referenced bolded text should be removed from the new CPCN for Norfolk County.
