LETTER OF COMMENT

Comments:

To Whom It May Concern, Our house is in close proximity to the power lines. We have the following concerns about the Durham Kawartha Power Line Project. Increased noise emanating from the lines. We raised this concern at the initial open house and with the real estate representative from Hydro One but our questions have not been answered or addressed in any way. Damage to property. An assessment was done that required the plowing of sections of land under the lines in the right of way. The subject area was not staked and the plow went quite substantially out of the right of way, creating a big swath of field that we now cannot cut or pass through. Hydro One declined to make reparations. We are now concerned that areas outside of the right of way will be damaged during construction and future maintenance of the new lines, and we will have no recourse. Overall, we feel that in our case Hydro One has not acted in good faith. We were given the impression that Hydro One would work with landowners to address concerns and come up with solutions to problems, yet we personally have received no meaningful support of this nature.
