Pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's (the "OEB") Rules of Practice and Procedure and the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, (the "**Practice Direction**") we are writing to submit the cost claim of FuteCAN Canada Inc. ("**FuteCAN**") for their participation in the EB-2025-0290 proceeding.

FuteCAN is claiming its legal costs, adjusted to the hourly rate permitted by the OEB Tariff, it incurred to support FuteCAN's intervention in EB-2025-0290. The total amount claimed is **\$11,097.70, in legal fees, exclusive of HST.** There is \$1442.70 in HST payable on these legal services. The total claim (legal fees + HST) is \$12,540.40.

Our complete cost submission has been entered directly into the OEB Cost Claim Portal. This letter serves as our formal cover note and verification package accompaniment.

In accordance with Section 10 of the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, we confirm and provide the following:

1. **Eligibility to Apply for a Cost Award:** FuteCAN is eligible to apply for a costs award pursuant to section 3.03 c) of the Practice Direction, as FuteCAN is a person with an interest in land that is affected by the process. FuteCAN owns land at 9941 Lundy's Lane (the "**FuteCAN Property**") and is the owner and operator of the Lundy Manor Wine Cellars ("**Lundy Manor**") located at the FuteCAN Property. FuteCAN sought intervenor status to make submissions related to the routing of the Welland-Thorold Transmission Line Project. FuteCAN submitted the initial proposed alignment followed an inefficient route, transecting a significant portion of the FuteCAN Property, and significantly

impacting the Futecan Property, rather than running along the road right-of-way. During the OEB proceeding, Hydro One changed the proposed route alignment to run along the roadway right-of-way, resulting in a reduced impact on the Futecan Property. Futecan's participation in the OEB proceeding thus had a material impact on the transmission line alignment and resulted in a beneficial outcome.

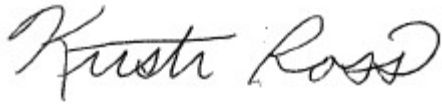
2. **Summary of Participation:** As per rule 5.01 of the Practice Direction, Futecan participated responsibly in all active stages of this proceeding to assist the Board, making every effort to focus on distinct issues and avoid duplicating the evidence or submissions of other consumer groups. Futecan's intervention contributed to a better understanding by the Board of one or more of the issues in the process; complied with the Board's orders, rules, codes, guidelines, filing requirements and any directions of the Board. The substance of Futecan's intervention and submissions were ultimately approved by the Board, and the Transmission line's routing was amended to run along the road right of way with a lesser impact on the Futecan Property.
3. **Accuracy of Claim:** All hours, fees, and disbursements claimed strictly adhere to the limits and parameters set out in the OEB Cost Award Tariff. The enclosed claim reflects the actual costs reasonably and necessarily incurred by Futecan for the purpose of participating in this proceeding and has been prepared in accordance with the OEB's Practice Direction on Cost Awards and the applicable Cost Award Tariff. The hours and rates claimed are within the limits prescribed by the OEB's tariff, and the claim includes only those fees and disbursements reasonably attributable to participation in this proceeding.
4. **Filing Method:** This material is submitted via the OEB Regulatory Electronic Submission System (RESS) in a searchable, unrestricted PDF format.
5. **Service on Parties:** A downloadable copy of the completed online portal cost claim form has been downloaded and is being served concurrently on the applicant, Hydro One Networks Inc., via their designated regulatory representative, as well as any other parties required under the distribution list.
6. **Request for Extension of Time to File Costs Submission:** Counsel for Futecan drafted and sent a letter July 27, 2026, requesting that the Board allow Futecan an extension of time to file their costs submissions, as well as an extension of time for Hydro One to respond. The OEB granted an extension to July 29, 2026, at midnight. It is submitted that expending both timeframes will ensure there is no prejudice to Hydro One.

Futecan respectfully requests that the Ontario Energy Board review and approve the enclosed cost claim and process the claim in accordance with the procedures established by the Practice Direction.

Pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's (the "OEB") Rules of Practice and Procedure and the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, (the "**Practice Direction**") we are writing to submit the cost claim of FuteCAN Canada Inc. ("**FuteCAN**") for their participation in the EB-2025-0290 proceeding.

FuteCAN is claiming its legal costs, adjusted to the hourly rate permitted by the OEB Tariff, it incurred to support FuteCAN's intervention in EB-2025-0290. The total amount claimed is **\$12,892.07, in legal fees, exclusive of HST.** There is \$1,676.05 in HST payable on these legal services. The total claim (legal fees + HST) is \$14,568.75.

Our complete cost submission has been entered directly into the OEB Cost Claim Portal. This letter serves as our formal cover note and verification package accompaniment.

In accordance with Section 10 of the *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, we confirm and provide the following:

1. **Eligibility to Apply for a Cost Award:** FuteCAN is eligible to apply for a costs award pursuant to section 3.03 c) of the Practice Direction, as FuteCAN is a person with an interest in land that is affected by the process. FuteCAN owns land at 9941 Lundy's Lane (the "**FuteCAN Property**") and is the owner and operator of the Lundy Manor Wine Cellars ("**Lundy Manor**") located at the FuteCAN Property. FuteCAN sought intervenor status to make submissions related to the routing of the Welland-Thorold Transmission Line Project. FuteCAN submitted the initial proposed alignment followed an inefficient route, transecting a significant portion of the FuteCAN Property, and significantly

impacting the Futechan Property, rather than running along the road right-of-way. During the OEB proceeding, Hydro One changed the proposed route alignment to run along the roadway right-of-way, resulting in a reduced impact on the Futechan Property. Futechan's participation in the OEB proceeding thus had a material impact on the transmission line alignment and resulted in a beneficial outcome.

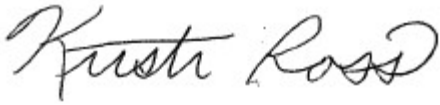
2. **Summary of Participation:** As per rule 5.01 of the Practice Direction, Futechan participated responsibly in all active stages of this proceeding to assist the Board, making every effort to focus on distinct issues and avoid duplicating the evidence or submissions of other consumer groups. Futechan's intervention contributed to a better understanding by the Board of one or more of the issues in the process; complied with the Board's orders, rules, codes, guidelines, filing requirements and any directions of the Board. The substance of Futechan's intervention and submissions were ultimately approved by the Board, and the Transmission line's routing was amended to run along the road right of way with a lesser impact on the Futechan Property.
3. **Accuracy of Claim:** All hours, fees, and disbursements claimed strictly adhere to the limits and parameters set out in the OEB Cost Award Tariff. The enclosed claim reflects the actual costs reasonably and necessarily incurred by Futechan for the purpose of participating in this proceeding and has been prepared in accordance with the OEB's Practice Direction on Cost Awards and the applicable Cost Award Tariff. The hours and rates claimed are within the limits prescribed by the OEB's tariff, and the claim includes only those fees and disbursements reasonably attributable to participation in this proceeding.
4. **Filing Method:** This material is submitted via the OEB Regulatory Electronic Submission System (RESS) in a searchable, unrestricted PDF format.
5. **Service on Parties:** A downloadable copy of the completed online portal cost claim form has been downloaded and is being served concurrently on the applicant, Hydro One Networks Inc., via their designated regulatory representative, as well as any other parties required under the distribution list.
6. **Request for Extension of Time to File Costs Submission:** Counsel for Futechan drafted and sent a letter July 27, 2026, requesting that the Board allow Futechan an extension of time to file their costs submissions, as well as an extension of time for Hydro One to respond. The OEB granted an extension to July 29, 2026, at midnight. It is submitted that expending both timeframes will ensure there is no prejudice to Hydro One.

Futechan respectfully requests that the Ontario Energy Board review and approve the enclosed cost claim and process the claim in accordance with the procedures established by the Practice Direction.
