The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Wataynikaneyap Power's application for approval to dispose of EPC COVID-Related Costs Deferral Account (Notice). The post(s) is required to include the short-form description and to provide a link to the Notices as posted on Wataynikaneyap Power's website in accordance with paragraph 1. Please tag @OntEnergyBoard on X and @OntarioEnergyBoard on LinkedIn when posting on these social media platforms. The OEB does not have a Facebook or Instagram account.

4. To provide a copy of the Notices, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.
5. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter (including, for example, courier proof of delivery or other courier tracking record showing delivery date and time, acknowledgment emails / read receipts).

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notices other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
