Re: EB-2026-0059 Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. – Application for 2027 Rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received your 2027 Price Cap IR application on August 11, 2026.

The OEB has commenced processing the application and has assigned it file number EB-2026-0059. An employee of the OEB, to whom authority has been delegated under Section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, intends to make a decision on the application without holding a hearing.

Your application is available on the OEB's [2027 Electricity Distribution Rates](#) webpage. You are directed to make a copy of the application available in a prominent place on your company's website within three business days.

OEB staff has set a date for a virtual kick-off meeting on September 1, 2026, where you will have the opportunity to meet your case manager and discuss any matters related to your application. Please inform your OEB case manager if this date is unworkable. OEB staff will also be in contact with you directly throughout the proceeding and may have questions regarding the application that will require your prompt attention.

Please note that you are responsible for ensuring that all of the documents filed with the OEB, including responses to OEB staff questions and any other supporting evidence, **does not include “personal information”** as that phrase is defined in the *Freedom of*

Information and Protection of Privacy Act, unless filed in accordance with rule 9A of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*.

If any additional information is received from you in response to OEB staff questions, OEB staff will update the applicable models filed with your application, as necessary. All changes to the models will be documented and provided to you no later than October 16, 2026. OEB staff will also outline any additional information that you need to provide.

If you have any comments regarding the updated models, please provide them to your OEB case manager together with any additional information requested of you, by no later than October 23, 2026.

Following these steps, the OEB will provide you with a draft decision and, where possible, a draft rate order and applicable models. You will be given seven days within which to provide comments on the draft decision (and, in some circumstances, you may need to file a separate draft rate order). The OEB will consider your comments (if any), prior to issuing a final decision and rate order.
