

Hydro One Networks Inc.

Application for leave to construct a new electricity transmission line from the Dobbin Transformer Station to the Clarington Transformer Station in Eastern Ontario

**WRITTEN INTERROGATORIES BY THE INTERVENORS,
BRIAN & MANDYJENSEN**

In accordance with the Procedural Order issued August 12, 2026, the Intervenor, owners of properties known as 1941 Concession Road 10 in Blackstock, Ontario and 262 Ballyduff Road in Pontypool, Ontario (the “**Properties**”) provide the following questions to be answered by Hydro One Networks Inc. (“**HONI**”):

1. To provide the following documents:
 - (a) Grading and regrading drawings with respect to the Properties;
 - (b) Construction drawings relating to the bases of the towers, including the class and dimensions.
2. To advise as to the construction timeline for the towers being built on the Properties, including when HONI anticipates commencing work on the Properties and when they anticipate being done with the work on the Properties;
3. To advise as to the exact location of the towers on the Properties;
4. To advise as to the kilovolts of the transmission lines and towers being placed on, over, and across the Properties;
5. To provide schematics of the towers and lines, including the magnitude/clearance from ground level, and details on what the base that the towers will be located on;

6. To advise how far apart each tower will be from the other on the Properties;
7. To advise when HONI will be required to have access to the Properties, as well as the details for same, including what types of vehicles, equipment and machinery (including helicopters), will be required to attend the Properties, and how they will access the location of the Towers;
8. To advise if there will be substations located on either of the Properties;
9. To advise if HONI will be implementing any mitigating plans to reduce any potential adverse impacts and if there will be emergency and/or evacuation plans shared with affected property owners; and
10. To advise whether the existing 230kv line is to be decommissioned and its lines and towers removed, and if so, the particulars regarding timing and restoration of the subject lands.
