The application seeks to embed DSM costs based on EGI's proposed DSM framework in EB-2025-0295, including its proposed total budget and allocation of costs to rate classes, despite the fact that the application has yet to resolve and EGI has sought an extension of the 2026 DSM program into 2027 pending resolution of EB-2025-0295.

- a) Please recalculate the proposed 2027 rates to be implemented January 1, 2027, using the 2026 DSM budget and allocation to rates in Working Papers Schedule 9, page 1, column a) instead of the proposed 2027 DSM budget and allocation to rates in Working Papers Schedule 9, page 1, column b).
- b) Please provide an update as to the earliest date the proposed harmonization of rates under phase 2 could be implemented.
- c) Please explain the origin and justification for the proposed allocation of DSM costs across the various elements of each rate class (i.e. the split of DSM costs between a demand charge and a volumetric charge, where applicable). Please explain why the split between rate components is different between classes.
